Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government will be carrying out safety improvement work on Alford's Point Road as part of the Road Safety Stimulus Program to provide a safer environment for road users.

What is planned?

Safety improvements will be delivered along Alfords Point Road, between Brushwood Drive and New Illawarra Road, Menai.

What work are we doing?

Drainage and Wire Rope Upgrades will be made on Alford's Point Road between Brushwood Drive and New Illawarra Road, Menai. These include a 2.6km long median rope wire barrier and drainage improvements as well as a new guard rail under the Brushwood Drive Bridge.

Work will include removing and replacing asphalt. Equipment used will include a profiler, paver, jackhammer, excavator, tip truck, crane truck, concrete truck, hand compactor, chain saw, and road sweeper.

When we'll be working

Work is expected to start in January and will take around four months to complete.

We will be onsite for 70-night shifts between **Tuesday 28 January to Thursday 26 June 2025**, weather permitting. Work hours will be between **8pm and 5am**. Work is expected to occur for up to five consecutive nights. We will not work on Sundays and public holidays.

Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times. We will take measures to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use, concentrating noisy activities together to limit the duration of impacts, and completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Traffic Impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures, traffic control, and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place, which may affect travel times.

Any road closures will be communicated to residents well in advance.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the directions of traffic controllers and signage.


