

Great Western Highway lane changes and T-Way bus stop relocation, Parramatta from Sunday 18 May 2025

Community notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW, as part of the NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program, will make lane changes at the intersection of Great Western Highway and Pitt Street, Parramatta. To enable these changes, a T-Way bus stop will also be relocated as part of this work.

The Bus Priority Infrastructure Program delivers infrastructure and operational changes to improve safety, journey time, reliability, and efficiency of bus services in Greater Sydney.

Changes to the Great Western Highway eastbound lanes, and relocation of the T-Way bus stop, aim to improve traffic flow and road safety through the intersection and provide more reliable travel times for bus users and motorists.

What work are we doing?

The work will be carried out over two stages.

Stage one work will start from **Sunday 18 May** and be completed by **Friday 27 June 2025**. Work activities will include:

- extending the eastbound bus lane on Great Western Highway by about 160 metres from Good Street
- merging the existing eastbound Great Western Highway left turn lane and bus lane into a single left turn lane into Pitt Street
- realigning the three (reduced from four) eastbound Great Western Highway lanes
- removing the 'B' lanterns from the traffic signals and optimising signal timing to improve efficiency

- completing signage, road resurfacing and line marking works on Great Western Highway eastbound lanes
- closing the eastbound bus stop on Great Western Highway in front of Parramatta High School (Stop ID 2150302) and relocating to Pitt Street (Stop ID 2150396)
- installing benches, pedestrian safety fencing, and temporary signage at the new Pitt Street bus stop location.

Stage two work will involve installing a bus shelter at the relocated bus stop on Pitt Street.

This work is planned to commence in late 2025.

We will notify the community again before we commence stage 2 work.

When will we be working?

We will be on site for up to **11 night shifts** between **Sunday 18 May** and **Friday 27 June 2025**, weather permitting.

We will work between **Sunday** and **Thursday, 8pm** and **5am**, the next day.

We will not work on Friday nights or Saturdays or on the Monday 9 June public holiday.

We will work up to **five nights per week** to complete the work as quickly as possible to minimise our impacts to the community.

What will this mean for you and how will we manage it?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.



It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- completing noisier tasks by midnight
- using quieter equipment where possible.

Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. This will include road detours, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

When carrying out road resurfacing work on Great Western Highway, access to Pitt Street from Great Western Highway will not be possible.

During this time, motorists will need to use the next available side street or follow the signposted detour route to redirect to their destination.

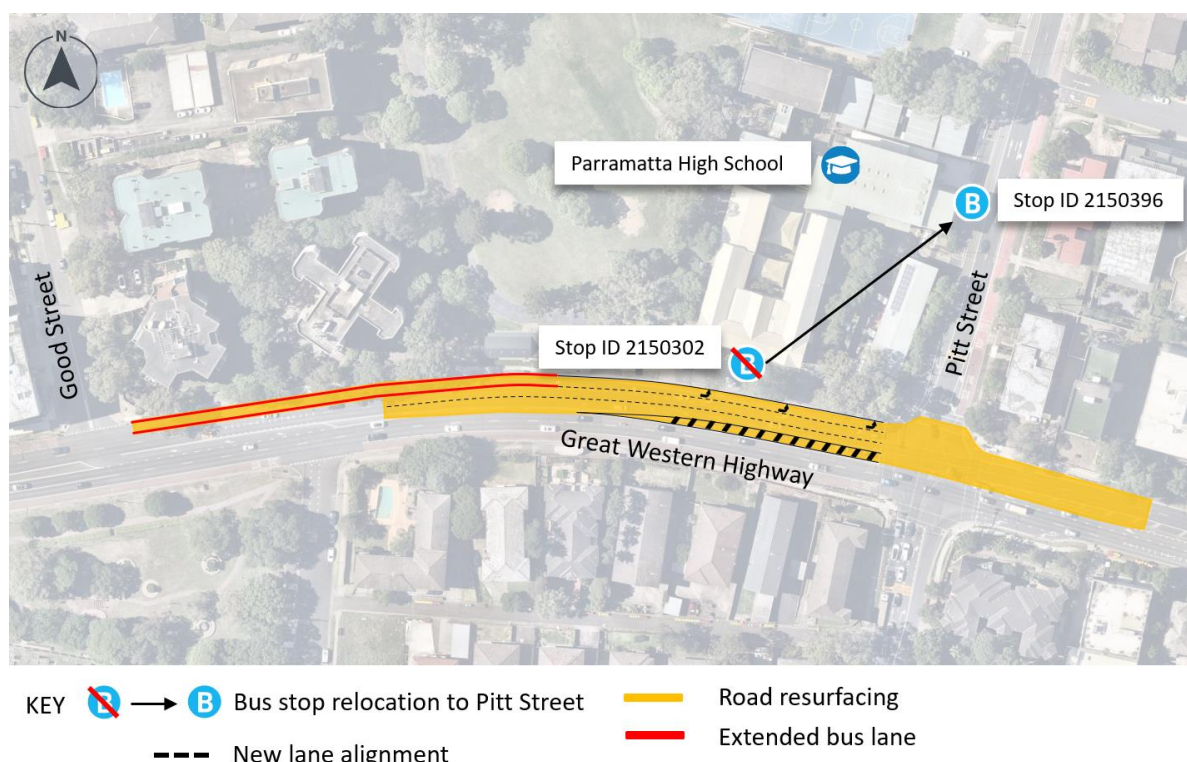
Temporary traffic signals may be used while we make changes to the lanterns.

Access to the pedestrian crossings and footpaths will be maintained under the guidance of traffic controllers.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
