Transport for NSW is progressing the Bandon Road Upgrade and Extension project, which includes early works at Vineyard Station to improve safety and access for motorists and pedestrians.

Transport has recently awarded the tender to Arup Australia Pty Limited to develop the concept design and Review of Environmental Factors for the Bandon Road Upgrade and Extension.

The design will include a new 6.5 kilometre, four lane road, connecting Windsor Road and Richmond Road at Elara Boulevard. The road features a central median to allow for future widening, a shared path for pedestrians and cyclists, a new road underpass of the Richmond railway line at Vineyard, and an upgrade and realignment of the existing flood evacuation route along Wallace Road and Bandon Road.

Early safety works at Vineyard Station

Transport have identified early safety works, at the corner of Bandon Road and Riverstone Parade, Vineyard, which will provide a safer intersection for motorists and pedestrians, including the following:

- a commuter car park with more than 70 parking spaces for motorists using train services at Vineyard station
- accessible parking and improved bus stop facilities for northbound and southbound services

- intersection improvements for motorist safety and a pedestrian refuge for safe crossing of Riverstone Parade
- modern pedestrian footpaths, road kerbs and wayfinding signage
- landscaping with garden beds and low growth vegetation.

How can you be involved

Transport is seeking feedback from the community on the proposed design of the early safety works at Vineyard Station. Our Have Your Say portal will be open for comments from 24 March to 6 April 2025.

What's happening

Site investigations are still taking place along the corridor to collect data to progress concept design and environmental assessment, including:

- survey and utility investigations
- geotechnical digging and drilling holes to take samples of existing ground conditions
- environmental investigations
- traffic survey.

There may be noisy work at times. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance to residents and local businesses where possible.
