

Bardwell Park Station Upgrade Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

August 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Bardwell Park Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

In July work included:

- Concrete foundation work on the station platform
- Excavation on the station platform for a new lift pit
- Installation of platform screening
- Establishment of the temporary site compound within Girrahween Park

What work are we doing?

In August, construction activities will include:

- Ongoing construction of a new lift pit behind platform screening
- Construction of concrete support columns and a lift shaft
- Concrete foundation work on the station platform

When we'll be working

In August, standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.

Out-of-hours work

From 11:30pm to 4:30am on Wednesday 6 and Thursday 7 August, line marking work will take place on the station platform.

This activity has been scheduled at night when trains are not running to reduce the impact to rail customers and improve safety for workers.

Project site compound

A temporary site compound has been established within Girrahween Park on the eastern side of Hartill-Law Avenue, opposite the intersection with Bray Road.

The use of this space for the project's site compound has been approved by the National Parks and Wildlife Service and strict environmental controls in place to protect the area, including Wolli Creek.

Access to the Girrahween Track remains open to the public.

Temporary reduction in speed limit on Hartill-Law Avenue

To improve the safety of pedestrians, motorists and construction workers during the station upgrade, a temporary speed limit of 40km/h has been introduced for all vehicles travelling along Hartill-Law Avenue until late 2026.

Signage along Hartill-Law Avenue is in place to inform motorists of the new speed limit. Please take care as speed limits are enforceable.



Rail Safety Week

Running from 11 - 17 August, Rail Safety Week reminds us all to limit distractions, hold onto handrails, and stand behind the safety line on train platforms.






Image: Bardwell Park Station Upgrade construction activities in July 2025
