

# Bardwell Park Station Upgrade – Community Notification

## Safe Accessible Transport program

March 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Bardwell Park Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

### Key features of the upgrade at Bardwell Park Station include

- A new lift, stairs and elevated walkway connecting Hartill-Law Avenue to the station platform
- A possible new pedestrian crossing on Hartill-Law Avenue for accessibility and passenger safety
- Canopy coverage from the station entry to both Boarding Assistance Zones
- An accessible parking space, an accessible kiss and ride space, additional bike parking and upgrade of bus stops on Hartill-Law Avenue
- A new family accessible toilet, a new unisex ambulant toilet, hearing loops, platform regrading and tactile indicators
- Safety improvements including lighting, CCTV, and wayfinding signage.

### What work are we doing?

During March, site establishment and early work on the station platforms will be underway.

Work includes:

- Establishing a temporary site compound
- Relocating existing services including electricity, CCTV and opal card readers

- Installation of plywood screening on the platform
- Installation of temporary access stairs
- Demolition of existing stairs.

### When and where we'll be working

During March, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

### Rail shutdown weekend and out-of-hours work

From **5am Saturday, 15 March to 10pm Sunday, 16 March 2025**, construction will occur on and around the station platforms during a scheduled trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running.

Some of this work may be noisy at times however, we will make every effort to minimise the impact to nearby residents and businesses.

This work will require a **single-lane road closure on Hartill-Law Avenue** between Slade Road and the entrance to the Earlwood Bardwell Park RSL Club on **Saturday 15 and Sunday 16 March**.

**Vehicle access to the RSL car park and pedestrian access across the bridge will remain open with traffic management in place.**

## Impacts to War Memorial garden

To enable these early construction activities to take place safely and to minimise impacts to the local community, a crane will be positioned within the lower portion of the RSL War Memorial garden on **Saturday, 15 and Sunday, 16 March**.

This activity will require the installation of concrete foundations for the crane to rest on and the removal of some vegetation within the memorial garden. Remedial landscaping will be undertaken following this work to restore the site.

We are working with the Earlwood Bardwell Park RSL Club to minimise impacts to the War Memorial and any disruption to the local community, club members and guests.

Transport is committed to ensuring the War Memorial garden remains an important community asset at the end of construction.

## Changes to car parking spaces within the RSL car park

There are some upcoming changes to car parking spaces in the RSL car park throughout March:

- Between **Monday, 10 March and Friday, 21 March**, eight car parking spaces at the western end of the RSL car park will be unavailable. These spaces will be used to house temporary site sheds.
- Between **Saturday, 15 and Sunday, 16 March**, 85 car parking spaces, including the eight disabled parking spaces, along the boundary

of the car park closest to the station will be unavailable.

To mitigate these parking impacts, **six temporary disability car parking spaces** will be allocated within the existing car park over the weekend of **Saturday, 15 and Sunday, 16 March**. These spaces will be clearly marked with signage.

## Changes to station access

From **Monday, 17 March 2025**, passengers will access Bardwell Park Station via a set of **temporary stairs on the eastern side of Hartill-Law Avenue** to enable the demolition of the existing station stairs and construction of the lift shaft and permanent stairs on the western-side of Hartill-Law Avenue.

Passengers are advised to allow extra time to safely cross the road at the signalised pedestrian crossing at the corner of Hartill-Law Avenue and Slade Road.

The temporary stairs are expected to be in place until mid-2026.

## Location of work area

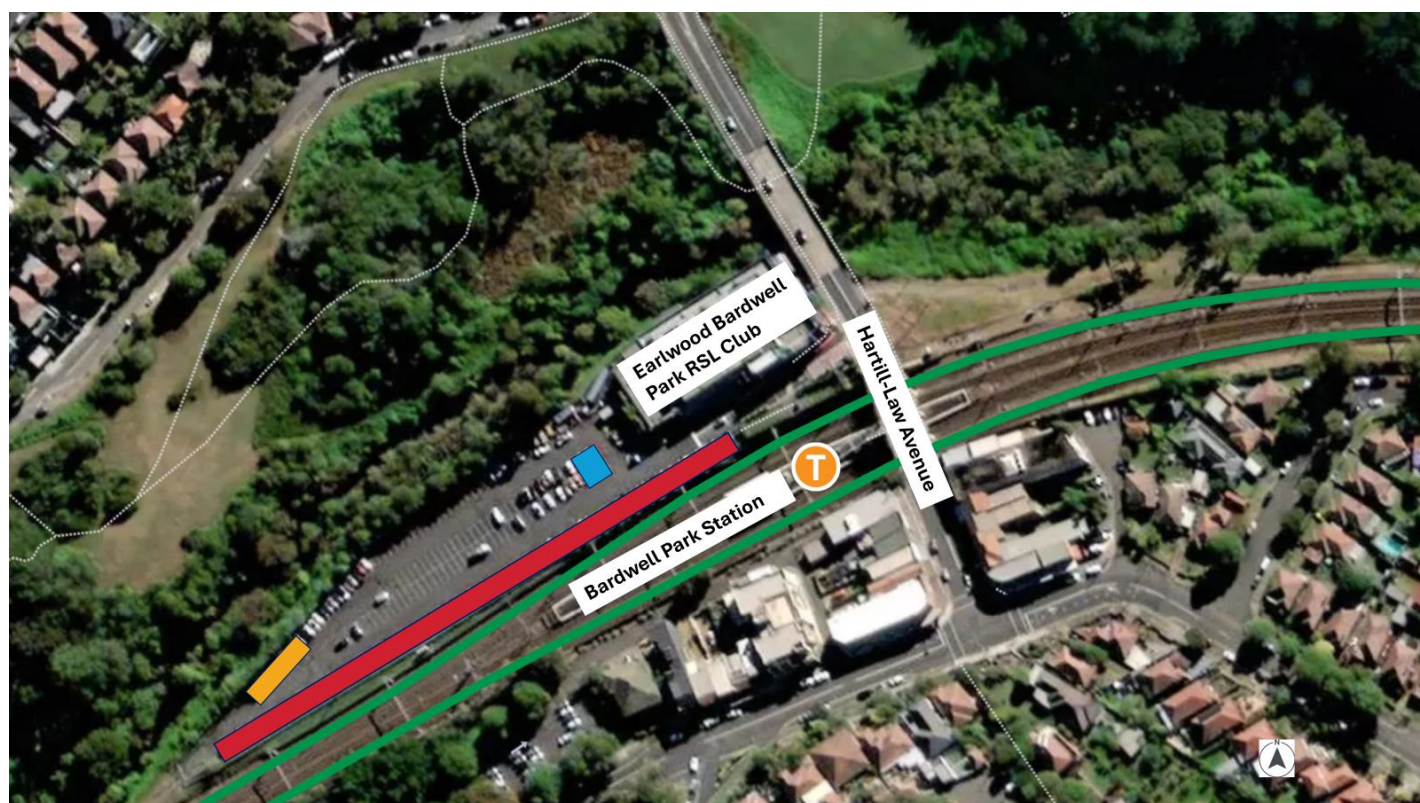


### Key

6 temporary disability car parking spaces will be allocated over the weekend of Saturday 15 and Sunday 16 March.



8 car parking spaces unavailable between Monday 10 and Friday 21 March. These spaces will be used to house temporary site sheds.
