Safety improvements on Bay Street between Moate Avenue and The Grand Parade, Brighton-Le-Sands

Road Safety Program

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gweagal, Bidjigal and Gadigal peoples as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out safety improvements on Bay Street between Moate Avenue and The Grand Parade, Brighton-Le-Sands. This work is being completed as part of the Road Safety Program.

The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$518 million to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads as part of the Road Safety Program launched in 2024.

Work outcomes and expected improvements

The purpose of this work is to improve the safety of pedestrians, lower vehicle speeds and reduce the likelihood of anti-social driving behaviour on Bay Street.

Changes to increase safety include:

- constructing a speed hump on both approaches to the mid-block signalised pedestrian crossing on Bay Street
- widening the kerb on the northern side of Bay Street at the signalised pedestrian crossing
- extending the central median along Bay Street between the mid-block signalised pedestrian crossing and Moate Avenue.

What work are we doing?

Our work tasks include:

- establishing a temporary work site
- locating existing underground services
- reconstructing kerb and gutter
- resurfacing sections of the road

- relocating traffic control system (TCS) posts
- removing, modifying and relocating signs.

When will we be working?

Work will start from **Sunday 11 May 2025** and will take up to 20 shifts to complete, weather permitting.

Working hours are **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.** There will be no work on Fridays, Saturdays, or public holidays.

Changes to traffic and pedestrian movement

To ensure the safety of road users and workers, temporary changes to traffic and pedestrian movement will be in place around the work zone.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signage.

What will this mean for you?

While this work takes place, you may notice:

- · workers and vehicles
- construction plant and machinery
- traffic controllers and signage.

There may be travel delays along Bay Street. Some parking spaces will be temporarily impacted during construction. There may also be minor route changes along footpaths.

Access to properties and businesses along Bay Street will be maintained at all times.

We thank the community for their patience while we complete this important work.

Managing our impacts


Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.

Work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise impacts by:

turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use

- completing noisier tasks, such as jackhammering, by midnight
- installing noise blankets
- using quieter equipment where possible.
- · site fencing for safety and security
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill.
