

Slope remediation work on Bells Line of Road, near Mount Tomah continuing from Thursday 5 December 2024

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW (Transport) is continuing slope repair and pavement work to improve road safety and resilience in the Blue Mountains.

Transport will continue work to stabilise a slope damaged by extreme weather events on Bells Line of Road approximately one kilometre west of Rainbow Ravine Road, near Mount Tomah.

Delivery has been impacted by weather, and we need to extend the works beyond the intended completion date of 5 December.

What work are we doing?

We will be:

- installing safety barriers
- clearing vegetation where needed
- scaling and removing loose rocks
- drilling and installing rock bolts, attaching the outer rock face to underlying material
- applying shotcrete.

When we'll be working

We will continue working on these slope repairs until **Thursday 23 January 2025**, weather permitting.

Work hours will be **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 7am to 1pm on Saturday.**

Nightworks hours will be from **8pm to 5am**. We will notify impacted stakeholders when these works are going to occur.

We will not work on Sundays or public holidays. There will also be no work during the Christmas shutdown period from 20 December 2024 to 3 January 2025.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment
- traffic signage
- traffic controllers to guide heavy vehicle access on and off site when needed.

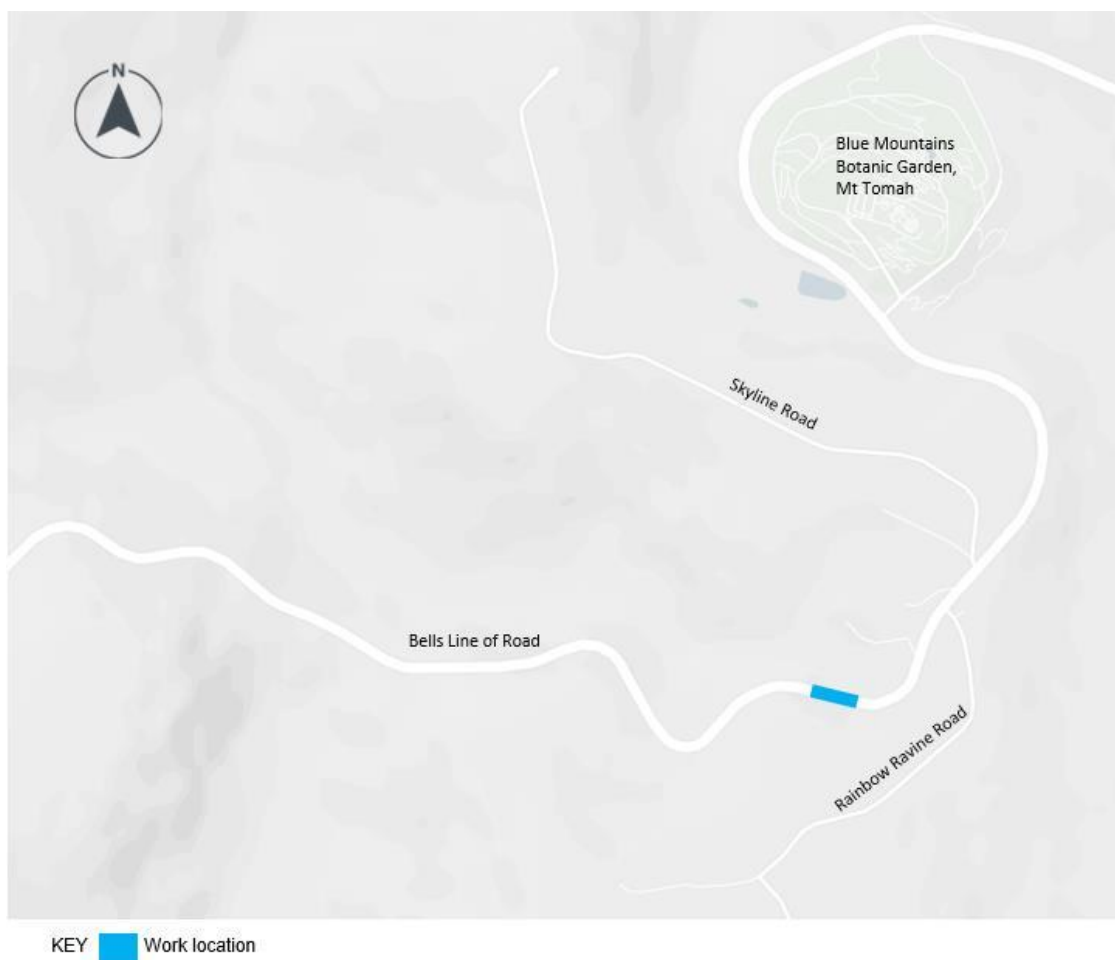
Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. These measures include:

- fencing for safety and security
- separating vehicle and pedestrian access
- turning off plant and equipment when not in use
- completing noisy activities earlier in the day where feasible.

Traffic impacts

For the safety of workers and road users, there will be some temporary traffic impacts while we work. This includes traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h. Static signs will inform drivers of truck movements.

Bells Line of Road will remain open while we work however traffic delays of up to five minutes may be experienced at times.
