

Upcoming Work on Bridge Road

Bridge Road Cycleway, Glebe

July 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal, Wangal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Work to deliver a range of improvements to Bridge Road including an upgraded cycleway, two raised pedestrian crossings and a resurfaced road, will continue in July.

Work is progressing well on Bridge Road. In May and early June, we completed trench excavation along parts of the route. Night work from 28 June will include trench restoration, milling and re-sheeting.

Weekend work has also been scheduled throughout the month of July to minimise disruptions to traffic and impacts on the community.

Upcoming night work

From **Tuesday 1 July to Thursday 31 July**, we'll be working for up to three nights per week at the following locations:

- Bridge Road between Railway Street and Darling Street
- Bridge Road between Railway Street and Lyndhurst Street

Our working hours are from **8pm to 5am**. Noisy and high impact work such as jackhammering and saw cutting will be carried out before midnight.

Weekend work from 28 June

In our June notification, we advised that work would be carried out between 21 and 22 June. This work has been rescheduled and will now be completed in July.

From **Saturday 28 to Sunday 29 June**, we'll be carrying out trench restoration work at the Lyons

Road and Bridge Road intersection extending past Barr Street.

Further trench restoration work will be carried out on Bridge Road between Ross Street and Glebe Point Road during the following weekends:

- **Saturday 5 July to Sunday 6 July**
- **Saturday 12 July to Sunday 13 July**

Later in the month, we'll be carrying out trench restoration, milling and resheeting work on Bridge Road between Lyons Road and Ross Street from:

- **Saturday 19 July to Sunday 20 July**
- **Saturday 26 July to Sunday 27 July**

More information, including times and locations of weekend work will be provided separately to directly impacted residents through notifications, which will also be uploaded to the project webpage.

What will this mean for you?

We'll be using, excavators, profilers, compaction equipment, concrete and tipper trucks to carry out our work. You'll also notice:

- Temporary traffic changes, road closures and reduced speed limits
- Footpath closures
- Detours with traffic controller on site to guide people using the footpath and bike riding
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

Night work requires the use of machinery that generates noise, light and vibration. To manage this, we'll implement a range of measures such as turning off machinery when not in use, installing

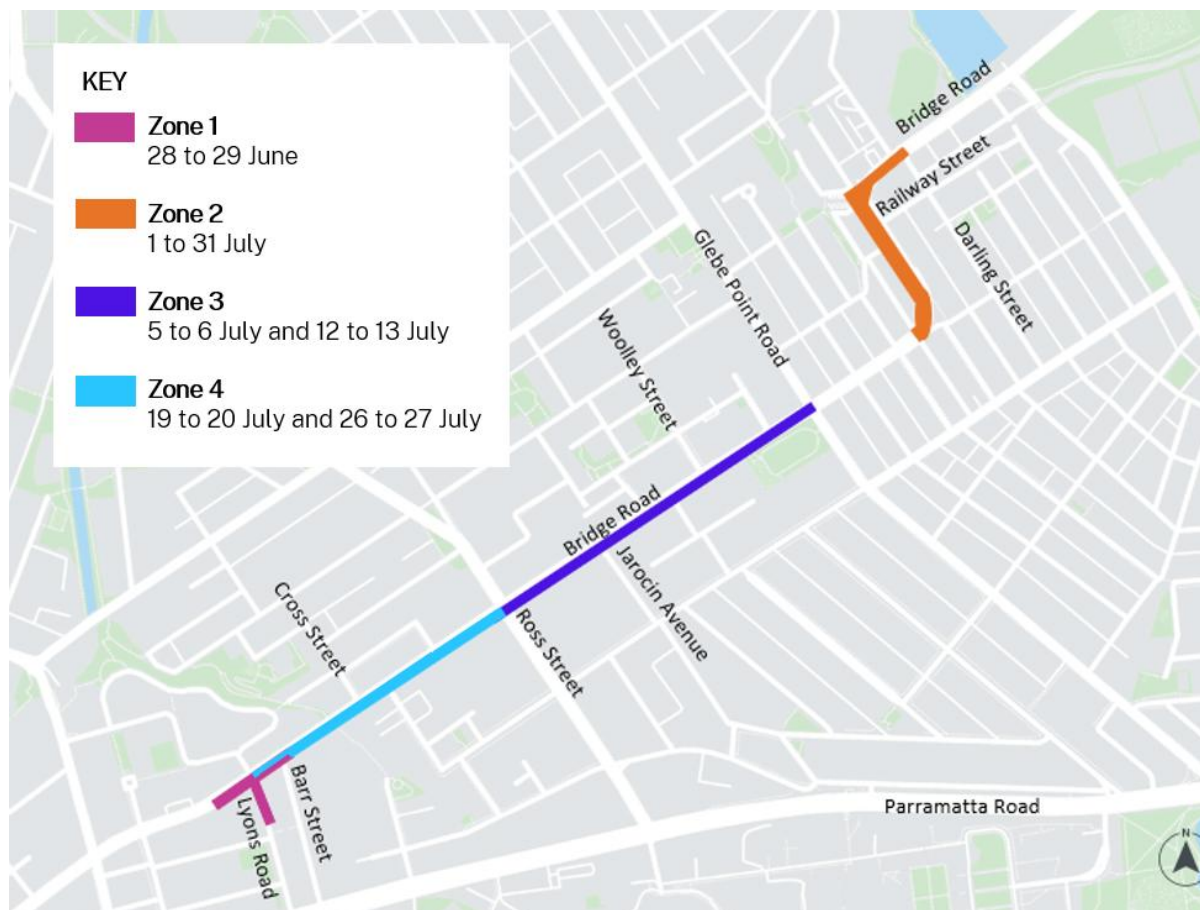


noise reducing blankets around construction sites and fitting equipment with devices to minimise noise. We thank you for your patience while we deliver this project.
