



Traffic improvements on Bunnerong Road, Pagewood

Start of work from Monday 19 May

Network Efficiency Program

Transport for NSW is improving safety and efficiency on Bunnerong Road in Pagewood.

We are making changes to improve safety and traffic flow around the Bunnerong Road and Birdwood Avenue intersection.

The changes include:

- removing right turns from Birdwood Avenue into Bunnerong Road
- removing right turns from Bunnerong Road into Birdwood Avenue
- widening the pedestrian refuge on Birdwood Avenue
- creating two new No Stopping zones along the northbound side of Bunnerong Road from 6am to 7pm, Monday to Friday
- installing new signs.

When we'll be working

Work will be done over **seven night shifts** between **Monday 19 May** and **Friday 27 June 2025**, weather and site conditions permitting. Our work hours will be between **8pm and 5am**. Work will not be scheduled on Fridays, Saturdays, or public holidays.

This work must be done at night to minimise traffic disruption and for the safety of our workers and other road users.

What will this mean for you?

Drivers will no longer be able to turn right into or out of Birdwood Avenue. Instead, they could use Prince Edward Circuit, located 150 metres north, which offers better visibility to oncoming traffic.

The No Stopping zone in both locations will replace up to 13 parking spaces during the day. There are alternative parking spaces on the surrounding streets.

These restrictions will be effective from the time that the signs are installed.

Project benefits

The project will improve traffic efficiency and safety for pedestrians, as well as reducing the risk of crashes for road users by:

- reducing lane changing and weaving
- Improving traffic flow
- widening the pedestrian refuge.

New No Stopping zones will:

- improve traffic flow by efficiently using all existing lanes and reducing queueing at Botany Street, resulting in more reliable travel times along Bunnerong Road.
- improve bus access to the bus stop to the south of Birdwood Avenue.

Managing our impacts

Work will be noisy at times, but we will reduce our noise as much as possible by using noise blankets, turning off equipment when not in use,



and completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Temporary road closure on Birdwood Avenue

Birdwood Avenue will be closed at Bunnerong Road for up to seven nights to widen the pedestrian refuge.

During the closures, a detour will be in place via Prince Edward Circuit.

Electronic message boards and signs will be in place to provide advance notice and detour directions.

Please follow guidance from traffic control.

Temporary traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes around the work zone, including partial lane closures and reduced speed limits which may affect travel times. We will maintain access for residents to their properties during the work.

Traffic control will be onsite to guide pedestrians and road users safely around the work zones. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
