

Chester Hill Station Upgrade – Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

April 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Chester Hill Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

During March, work included:

- Establishment of a temporary site compound in the rail corridor to the west of the station
- Demolition of a section of the station platform canopy
- Relocation of Opal ticket machine, lighting, speakers and CCTV
- Removal of vending machines from platform
- Installation of plywood screening on the platform to secure our construction area.

What work are we doing next?

In April, we will continue work on the detailed design of the station upgrade. As a result, there will be minimal construction activities taking place on and around the station over the course of the month. You may see construction workers in the area conducting surveys and other planning activities.

When and where we'll be working

In April, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

There is no planned work outside of standard construction hours in April. Should the need for any out-of-hours work arise, affected businesses

and residents will be notified prior to the work commencing.

Out-of-hours work next month (May)

From **5am Saturday, 3 May to 10pm Sunday, 4 May 2025**, construction on and around the station platforms and movement of machinery will occur on Waldron and Chester Hill Roads during a scheduled trackwork weekend when the station is closed, and trains will not be running

Pending council approvals, this work will require a **temporary road closure of Chester Hill Road between Waldron Road and Wellington Road**.

Pedestrian access across the bridge will remain open with traffic management in place.

Further updates about this work, including confirmation of the road closure and traffic management plans will be provided to the community in the next community notification later this month.

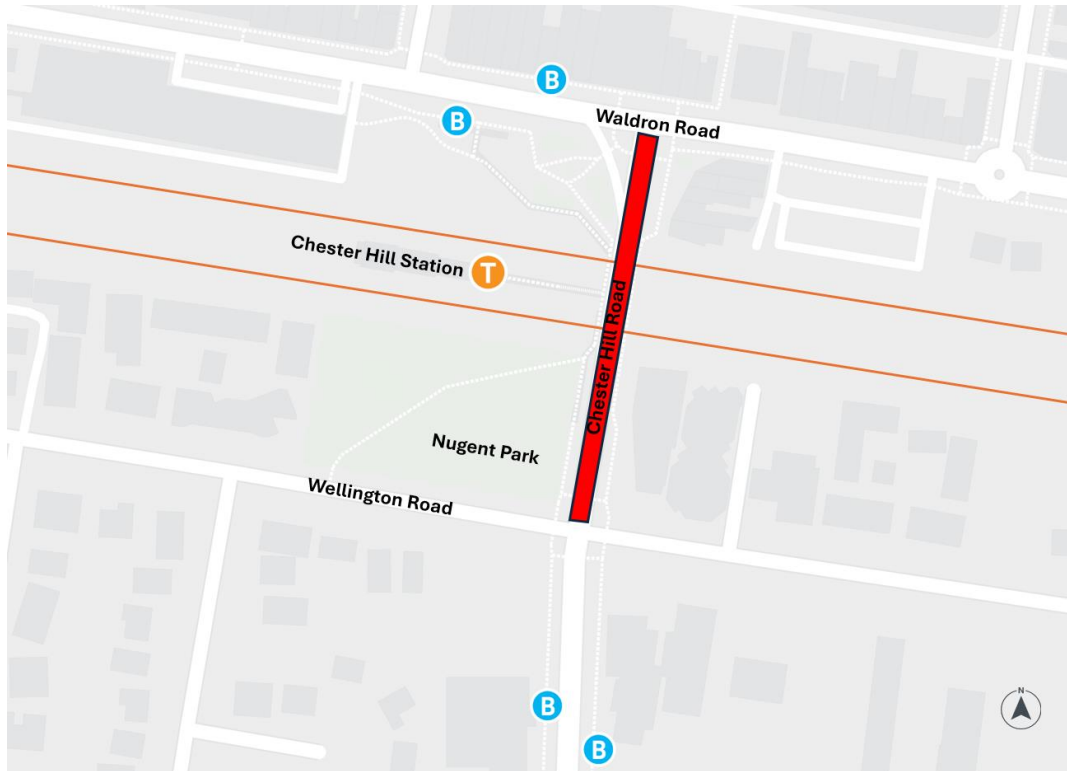
Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use
- Using quieter equipment where possible
- Providing traffic controllers and signage to direct road users and pedestrians.
