Transport for NSW is upgrading Chester Hill Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

Project update-improved design

As part of ongoing design development, we have identified an opportunity to refine the design and improve project outcomes. This month, you'll notice increased activity at the station as we start the preparatory work for the new lift shaft, elevated concourse and stairs.

Further features of the new design

- Wider entrance from Chester Hill Road to the Station platforms
 This will help reduce crowding at the station entrance, making it easier for people to get in and out.
- **Defined waiting area for the lift, and for stair access**The designated entrance area is bigger with a designated waiting area for the lift, allowing passengers to move around more easily.
- Clear view along the platforms, stairs and lift waiting areas

 There is better visibility along the platform from the lift waiting area, improving passenger safety and making it easier for station staff to watch over the area.
- Weather protection along Chester Hill Road footpath
 A canopy will cover the footpath all the way to the bus stops on Chester Hill Road, keeping passengers dry in bad weather.

What work are we doing?





Work during May includes:

- Foundation work for the new elevated concourse, stairs, platform canopy and lift shaft
- Closure of existing toilets and installation of a temporary unisex toilet on the platform
- Relocating existing electrical and communications services
- Installation of plywood screening underneath the existing station entrance and in other areas on the platform to provide a safe work area.

This work will require a road closure on Chester Hill Road between Waldron Road and Wellington Road on Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 May with northbound and southbound traffic diversions in place.

Pedestrian access across Chester Hill Road rail bridge will remain open on the western side, with traffic management in place. Pedestrians can still walk to polling booths on Saturday 3 May, as road closures apply to vehicles only, and pedestrian access remains open.

Rail replacement buses will be in service as there will be no trains operating during the scheduled trackwork weekend.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Service investigation using high-pressure trucks
- Mobile cranes to lift materials in and out of the worksites
- · Workers and large and light construction vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage helping facilitate vehicle and pedestrian detours
- Machinery and equipment noise, which will be noisy at times.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by turning of equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers
- Providing traffic controllers and signage to direct vehicles and pedestrians
- Undertaking noisy work during the day wherever possible.


Workshops with local people with disability
