What we are doing

Sydney Trains will be replacing the boundary fence between 18 - 42 Lower Fort Street, Dawes Point from Monday 15 September to Friday 19 September.

The fence at the back of your property is owned by Transport for NSW (TfNSW) and needs to be replaced due to premature wear of the timber.

TfNSW will cover the full cost of the work, and no contribution will be required from residents.

Work activities include:

- Removing the existing fence from within TfNSW land
- · Installing new footings
- Replacing timber posts and rails with stronger galvanized steel while keeping the heritage look
- Reinstalling fence panels, shaped to match the natural slope of the ground
- Any plants or vegetation growing on the fence will need to be removed during this work.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Noise

- These works may create additional noise during the day.
- Work will take place from 7am to 5pm between Monday 15 September and Friday 19 September.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times.

Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the worksite. Please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near worksites.
- Traffic controllers will be on duty to assist motorists and pedestrians throughout the duration of the works.
