Essential road maintenance on Caswell Street, Peak Hill

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential road maintenance work on Caswell Street in Peak Hill from Wednesday 16 July.

What work are we doing?

The work will include asphalt patching, which involves removing the failing areas of the road pavement down to a specific depth and laying and compacting new layers of asphaltic concrete to provide a more durable and stable pavement which creates a smoother road surface.

Work will occur at four sections of Caswell Street, including:

- Caswell Street, between Bingara Street and Narra Street
- Caswell Street, between Mingelo Street and Ween Street
- Caswell Street, 65m North of Ingalba Street
- Caswell Street, 235m North of Ingalba Street

We have included a map to show the location of our work area.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working between **6am and 5pm, Monday to Sunday**, from **Wednesday 16 July 2025**.

We will start working at the section closest to Bingara Street and progressively move north and spend approximately four days at each section, weather permitting.

When working between Mingelo and Ween Streets, some overhanging vegetation will

need to be trimmed to ensure the work is completed.

We expect to complete the work within two weeks.

All work activities and dates are subject to weather and site conditions.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

The work will involve the use of Asphaltic Concrete hauling, laying and compacting plants and equipment, which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise where possible.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Single lane closures, intermittent stopping and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours. OSOM vehicles will be permitted to travel through the work site during daylight hours under the guidance of traffic control.

All vehicles need to be parked off the street during work hours.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.


