



Gosford Station Lift No 4 upgrade

From Friday 25 July to Sunday 12 October 2025

What we are doing

Sydney Trains is undertaking major lift replacement work at Gosford Station from Friday 25 July to Sunday 12 October.

To improve service reliability, reduce the need for ongoing maintenance and enhance customer facilities, we will be upgrading Lift No 4. This lift provides access from the Street level to Concourse level.

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding.

How this affects you

Access to concourse

- **Lift No 4 will be unavailable from Sunday 27 July to Sunday 12 October. During the work, access to the Concourse will be via the lift and stairs on Platform 1.**
- To ensure work can be undertaken safely and efficiently, the work area will have temporary hoarding in place.
- We aim to have the lift reopened on Monday 13 October.

Traffic and parking

- Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to transport equipment to and from the work area.

Noise

- These works may create additional noise at night and over the weekend.
- **Work will take place from:**
 - 7am to 5pm Friday 25 July and Saturday 26 July to prepare hoarding. The lift will still be available during this time.
 - 7am to 5pm Sunday 27 July to install hoarding. The lift will be unavailable during this time.
 - 7am to 5pm Monday to Saturday, between Monday 28 July and Sunday 12 October to replace the lift. The lift will be unavailable during this time.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside of this time. Due to travel restrictions on large vehicles, some of these deliveries may need to take place at night.
- Finishing works may take place following this period, including the removal of equipment.
