Night work on Hampden Bridge from Sunday 10 August

Bridge repairs

July 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wodi Wodi people of Dharawal-speaking Country as the Traditional Custodians of Gangagruwan and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW (Transport) will carry out repairs on Hampden Bridge at Kangaroo Valley from 10 August 2025.

Repairs will support the continued use of the bridge at its current 23 tonne load limit and reduce the risk of further damage.

What work are we doing?

Transport will repair and replace the damaged timber trusses on Hampden Bridge.

Work includes:

- drilling into the bridge deck and installing temporary access support for workers
- workers in safety harnesses carrying out repairs on the bridge's exterior
- · removing damaged timber trusses
- installation of new trusses
- safety and structural checks once work is completed.

When we'll be working

Work will be carried out from **8pm to 5am**, **Sunday to Thursday** nights between **Sunday 10 and Thursday 21 August 2025**, weather permitting.

Traffic impacts

Hampden Bridge will be completely closed to motorists during work hours.

Pedestrians will be able to cross the bridge during work under the guidance of traffic control. During work, detours will be in place via Macquarie Pass, adding up to 90 minutes' additional travel time.

On Friday 15 and Friday 22 August, 7pm to 5am, stop/slow traffic control will be in place across Hampden Bridge while workers pack down equipment, adding up to ten minutes to travel times.

Outside of our work hours, Hampden Bridge will remain open with the reduced speed limit of 10 km/h in place for trucks and buses.


Examples of damaged timber trusses to be replaced

What will this mean for you?

During work, you may notice:

- changed traffic conditions and reduced speed limits
- traffic controllers onsite to escort pedestrians and cyclists across the bridge
- noise and light from machinery and equipment.

We will make every effort to minimise disruptions to residents and complete work as quickly as possible.

Managing our impacts

Regular inspections and maintenance on Hampden Bridge will continue over the next few months. You will be informed in advance of work.

While the community may notice small changes on the bridge, this work will not affect the bridge's character or its heritage value.
