# Hawkesbury River Railway Bridge maintenance

## From Monday 29 September 2025

## What we are doing

To improve service reliability, Sydney Trains is undertaking maintenance works on Hawkesbury River Railway Bridge from Monday 29 September 2025.

This is a long-term maintenance project that is expected to be completed in 2034.

Work activities include:

- Removal of existing lead-based paint and repainting of the bridge structure
- Installation and use of a containment structure for the safe undertaking of the works
- · Installation of new walkway
- Steel repairs

We understand this work may have an impact on you and we appreciate your patience and understanding. We will provide updates as the work progresses.

## How this affects you

#### Noise

- These works may create additional noise over the weekend and at night.
- Works will take place from 7am to 5.30pm Monday to Friday.
- Weekend work during track shutdowns will take place from 2am Saturday to 2am Monday. We will notify for these works separately.
- Equipment may be delivered to the worksite outside the above times. Some deliveries may occur at night due to daytime travel restrictions on large vehicles.

- Diesel work trains may have their engines running on site for an extended period.
- Finishing works including the removal of equipment may take place beyond the dates stated above.

#### Traffic and parking

- We will be utilising the wharf access road off
  Dangar Road at Hawkesbury River Station for
  access and egress of machinery, vehicles, and
  workers to the worksite. This will result in increased
  volume of traffic on the wharf access road.
- Heavy vehicles will use local streets to access the rail corridor. Parking may be limited near access gates.
- We will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, however please be aware that onstreet parking may be limited near worksites.


