## Heathcote Road Essential Slope Remediation work

#### Start of work

April 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

# Transport for NSW will realign 280 metres of Heathcote Road in Engadine, to provide a safe and efficient journey for road users.

The heavy rainfall events of 2022 resulted in two landslips along Heathcote Road, with the first occurring in April and the second in July.

Although emergency repairs were completed in 2022, the area continues to experience movement and remains a safety risk.

The remediation of Heathcote Road will move 280 metres of the existing road to stabilise the road against future collapses.

## What work are we doing

The first stage of work involves clearing of vegetation and trees to allow access to the uphill rock face.

The next stage of work will involve cutting into and stabilising the rock face, where the new road alignment will be constructed, and drainage will be upgraded.

## When and where we'll be working

Heathcote Road will be closed at various times between New Illawarra Road and Princes Highway from April to June 2025, weather permitting.

## What will this mean for you?

- detour in place and extended travel time
- workers and vehicles in the area
- noise from machinery and equipment.

#### Heathcote Road closures

Heathcote Road will be closed for the safety of motorists and workers while this essential work is underway. Closures will include:

#### Monday 7 April to Thursday 17 April

• each night from 8pm to 5am

#### 8pm Thursday 17 April to 5am Monday 28 April

full closure through the school term break,
Easter and Anzac holiday period

#### Monday 28 April to mid-June

- each night Monday to Thursday from 8pm to 5am
- weekends from 8pm Friday to 5am Monday.

During the full closure, Transport will temporarily reopen Heathcote Road in a single direction to support holiday makers on their journey to and from their destination including:

- northbound on Easter Monday 21 April from 3pm to 8pm
- southbound on Wednesday 23 April from 3pm to 8pm
- southbound on Thursday 24 April from 3pm to 8pm
- northbound on Sunday 27 April from 12pm to 8pm

## Detour during closures

A detour will be in place via New Illawarra Road, Bangor Bypass and Princes Highway during all closures of Heathcote Road. Please see the detour map on page 2.

Access to Forum Drive will be maintained during the road closures.



#### Managing our impacts


We aim to reduce impacts to the community and environment where possible, including:

- early notification of closures, real time updates through electronic road signs and Live Traffic NSW updates.
- reducing noise, turning off equipment when not in use and stopping work for respite periods.

Access for National Parks and Wildlife Services and emergency services will be maintained during the road closures.
