



Heathcote Road Essential Slope Remediation work

Project Update

May 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is realigning 280 metres of Heathcote Road in Engadine, to provide a safe and efficient journey for road users.

The heavy rainfall events of 2022 resulted in two landslips along Heathcote Road, with the first occurring in April and the second in July.

Although emergency repairs were completed in 2022, the area continues to experience movement and remains a safety risk.

The remediation of Heathcote Road will move 280 metres of the existing road to stabilise the road against future collapses.

What work are we doing

Continuing work will involve cutting into and stabilising the rock face, where the new road alignment will be constructed, and upgrading drainage.

When and where we'll be working

Heathcote Road will be closed at various times between New Illawarra Road and Princes Highway until mid-June 2025, weather permitting.

What will this mean for you?

- detour in place and extended travel time
- workers and vehicles in the area
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Heathcote Road closures

Thank you for your patience during the extended road closure over the Easter school holiday period.

For the safety of motorists and workers, Heathcote Road will continue to be closed during weeknights and weekends until **mid-June** during the following times:

- **Monday to Thursday** from **8pm to 5am**
- Weekends from **8pm Friday to 5am Monday**.

Heathcote Road will be open on Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 May between 5am and 8pm to allow better traffic flows over the Mother's Day weekend. The road will still close at nights between 8pm and 5am.

A detour will be in place via New Illawarra Road, Bangor Bypass and Princes Highway during all closures of Heathcote Road. Please see the detour map on page 2.

Access to Forum Drive will be maintained during the road closures.



Managing our impacts

We aim to reduce impacts to the community and environment where possible, including:

- early notification of closures, real time updates through electronic road signs and Live Traffic NSW updates.
- reducing noise, turning off equipment when not in use and stopping work for respite periods.

Access for National Parks and Wildlife Services and emergency services will be maintained during the road closures.
