Transport for NSW is upgrading a section of Hill Road.

We will be working between **6pm and 7am** on **Tuesday 22 and Wednesday 23 April**, weather permitting.

What work are we doing?

We will be working on Hill Road to:

- remove a section of the median
- remove trees from the median and along the site compound boundary.

Our work activities will include chainsawing, excavating, and asphaltting the road.



We will use equipment such as an excavator, compactor, chainsaw, trucks, lighting, and light vehicles.

What will this mean for you?

We will carry out our work at night to reduce disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks for our workers, pedestrians and motorists. The machinery used will generate some noise and vibrations.

We aim to minimise the impacts by completing noisier tasks earlier in the evening and ensuring vehicles are turned off when not in use.
