



# Investigation work at Orange and Millthorpe Stations

## Rail Infrastructure Upgrades

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is delivering new, state-of-the-art intercity and regional trains.

The new trains will provide new safety features, improved accessibility, facilities and reliability for passengers who travel on our intercity and regional networks.

To accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet, we need to upgrade and modify some existing rail infrastructure at various locations across the rail network.

In April 2025, \$2 million funding was announced to investigate suitable options and develop a concept proposal for a new stabling yard next to Orange Station. As part of this work, we are continuing to assess potential options for a new stabling yard at Orange.

### What work are we doing?

In August, work within the rail corridor at Orange and Millthorpe includes:

- surveying and laser scanning of the station and rail corridor
- geotechnical investigations to assess ground conditions
- site investigations on existing utilities and assets.

Equipment and machinery to be used:

- laser scanning and survey equipment
- bore hole drill rig
- general hand tools
- electrical and hydraulic testing equipment.

### When and where we'll be working

From **Monday 11 August** to **Friday 15 August 2025**, we will be working at and around **Orange** and **Millthorpe Stations** during standard construction hours, from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

### Temporary parking impacts at Orange Station

From **6am Monday 11 August** until **6pm Friday 15 August 2025**, approximately 10 car spaces will be unavailable in the commuter car park at **Orange Station**. These spaces are required to enable investigation work to be carried out safely. During this time, please do not park in the shaded red area shown on the map overleaf.



## What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- temporary fence removal in back corner of commuter car park at Orange Station
- noise from machinery and equipment.

## Managing our impacts

We will take steps to reduce noise and impacts on the community and the environment.

This includes and is not limited to:

- using non-tonal reversing beepers
