Kiss and Ride Upgrade

March 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the traditional Aboriginal owners and custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

We're upgrading the Leppington Station Kiss and Ride to make it easier and more efficient to drop off and pick up passengers who are connecting with train and bus services.

What work are we doing?

In **March**, work activities include:

- Removing and realigning existing footpaths, kerbs, gutters and road surface
- Removing existing safety bollards
- Building a new pedestrian crossing
- Modifying in-ground services
- Road re-surfacing.

When and where we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Low impact site set-up activities will occur from 6.30am.

Road re-surfacing is expected to occur at night in **March** to minimise impact to traffic and pedestrians. **Further notification, with dates and times, will be provided in advance.**

What will this mean for you?

A new pedestrian crossing will be built to the west of the current crossing. The existing crossing will remain open until the new one is completed. Vehicle access will be maintained with stop/go traffic controls.

Accessible car spaces and the Kiss and Ride area next to the station will have reduced capacity during this work. Motorists are encouraged to use the temporary Kiss and Ride in the southern car park or use the northern car park for 15-minutes

time limited pick-up and drop-off during the construction period.

Signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians with these changes.

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Temporary footpath closures
- Reduced Kiss and Ride and accessible spaces adjacent to the station
- Changed traffic conditions and reduced speed limit
- Noise from machinery and equipment including power tools, demolition saw, jack hammer, excavator, loaders, rollers, concrete truck and pump, various sized trucks and line markers.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. The site compound is designed to minimise impact.

This includes:

- Providing additional Kiss and Ride spaces in the commuter car park south of the station
- Fencing for safety and security
- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- Staging our work to maintain vehicle and pedestrian access.
