

# Leppington Station Kiss and Ride Upgrade

May 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the traditional Aboriginal owners and custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

We're upgrading the Leppington Station Kiss and Ride to make it easier and more efficient to drop off and pick up passengers who are connecting with train and bus services.

## What work are we doing?

In May, work activities include:

- removing and realigning existing footpaths, kerbs and gutters
- removing existing safety bollards, signage and street furniture
- building a new pedestrian crossing
- modifying in-ground services, street lighting, and road re-surfacing

#### When and where we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday** to **Friday** and **8am to 1pm, Saturday**. Low impact site set-up activities will start from 6.30am.

We will work at night in May to re-surface the road to minimise impact to traffic and pedestrians. Before this work starts, we will deliver another notice with dates and times to neighbouring properties.

The map on the next page shows our work areas.

# What will this mean for you?

We are building a new pedestrian crossing further west to provide more Kiss and Ride spaces. The existing crossing will remain open until the new one is finished. Cars can continue to access the station and car park with stop/go traffic controls.

Accessible car spaces and the Kiss and Ride area next to the station will have reduced capacity.

We encourage drivers to use the temporary Kiss and Ride in the southern car park or use the northern car park for 15-minute, time limited pick-up and drop-off during the construction period.

Traffic controllers and signs will assist drivers and pedestrians with these changes.

You may notice:

- workers and construction vehicles
- traffic controllers and signs
- temporary footpath closures
- reduced Kiss and Ride and accessible spaces
- changed traffic conditions and reduced speed limits
- construction equipment in use, including power tools, demolition saw, jack hammer, excavator, loaders, rollers, concrete truck and pump, trucks and line markers.

# Managing our impacts


We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community by:

- providing additional Kiss and Ride spaces in the south commuter car park
- installing safety fencing around our work areas
- reducing noise by turning off machinery when not in use
- staging our work to keep vehicle and pedestrian access open where we can.
