



Night work and traffic changes during September 2025

Mamre Road Upgrade Stage 1

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Wianamatta Country as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

What work are we doing this month?

Work will continue at **night** for up to **22 shifts** between **Monday 1 September** and **Tuesday 30 September**, weather permitting.

Night work activities will include:

- investigating, relocating and installing utilities and stormwater drainage
- clearing trees and vegetation within work areas
- widening, repairing and marking new lines on road surfaces
- delivering and removing equipment from work areas and site compounds/stockpile yards as needed.

We will notify nearby residents of the exact dates before starting our night work.

Upcoming day work activities

Our other work activities will continue during standard construction hours, and may include:

- investigating, locating and marking underground utility services
- relocating water, sewer, electricity, gas and telecommunications infrastructure

- digging and clearing soil for the new lanes
- delivering and storing material
- pouring concrete columns into the ground to support the noise wall
- building temporary and permanent road surfaces and access roads
- saw cutting and removing existing road surface, kerbs and islands
- removing old and installing new line marking.

Our work schedule

Working at night helps us keep road users and our workers safe. It also aims to keep people moving during peak travel times.

Our night shift hours will be from **6pm to 7am**, between **Monday night** and **Saturday morning**.

We will work no more than two consecutive nights, three nights a week and no more than 10 nights a month at the same location. A map showing our work area is over the page.

Where possible, we will work during the day, from 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday, and from 8am to 1pm, on Saturday.

What will this mean for you?

Our work may be noisy at times. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents by planning our work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

What equipment will we use?

During this work, we may use:

- excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes and boring rigs



- asphalt pavers, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, road saws, chainsaws, hand and power tools
- lighting towers, elevated working platforms, generators, welders and metal cutting equipment.

Mandalong Close traffic changes

We are working on new road pavement at the Mandalong Close and Mamre Road intersection. We will lay temporary road surface on the southern side of Mandalong Close over **two-night shifts on Wednesday 17 September and Thursday 18 September 2025**, weather permitting.

Traffic will begin to use the southern side of Mandalong Close from **Friday 19 September**

2025, weather permitting. This will allow work to progress on the northern side of Mandalong Close, with minimal disruption to road users. If our work dates change due to weather, we will notify you in advance of these changes and work activities.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes in place during our night shifts to ensure the work zone is safe for workers, residents and road users. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers.
