



# Macquarie Fields Station Upgrade – Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport Program

July 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Macquarie Fields Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

## What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- Laying concrete for the new lifts, footbridge, stairs and retaining walls
- Investigation of existing services, including lighting, CCTV and opal card readers and relocation where required

## When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Railway Parade, in and around Macquarie Fields Station, and within our site compound.

In July, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

## Out-of-hours work

We'll be working from **6am until 6pm on Saturday 12 July** during planned trackwork of the freight line, when the freight trains will not be running.

Directly impacted residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption.

## What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Temporary changes to parking near the station.
- Concrete trucks and pumps entering and exiting the worksites.
- Mobile cranes and delivery trucks to lift materials in and out of the worksites.

There will be some temporary changes for pedestrians and cyclists when we're working next to footpaths and at the station entrance. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist.

## Upcoming important changes to ramp access and parking

To support the upgrade, the ramp to Platform 2 will be temporarily closed from **late August until mid-2026**. The stairs will remain available. We recommend customers who require ramp or lift access visit [transportnsw.info](https://transportnsw.info) for information on their next nearest accessible station ahead of their journey.

We will also be relocating four accessible parking spaces further north on Railway Parade, closer to our site compound in **late August 2025 until mid-2026**. This will support station upgrade work and ensure continued access for customers with mobility needs. Alternative parking is available at the Council commuter car park on Railway Parade.

We apologise for any inconvenience and appreciate your understanding as we work to improve station accessibility.



## Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
- Providing traffic controllers or signage to direct pedestrians.
