



Macquarie Fields Station Upgrade – Community Notification

Safe Accessible Transport program

June 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharawal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Macquarie Fields Station to improve accessibility, convenience and safety.

What work are we doing?

- Excavation and concrete work for the new lifts, footbridge, stairs and retaining walls.
- Installation of new services on the platform as well as relocating services impacted by the work.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working on Railway Parade, in and around Macquarie Fields Station, and within our site compound.

In June, standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday**.

Out-of-hours work

We'll be working from **6am until 6pm on Saturday 7 June** during planned trackwork of the freight line, when the freight trains will not be running.

Directly impacted residents will be contacted and advised of the likely impact and what we are doing to minimise disruption during the work.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Temporary changes to parking near the station.
- Excavators and trucks carrying spoil dug out from the work.
- Mobile cranes to lift materials in and out of the worksites.
- Machinery to drill the foundation for the new lifts.

There will be some temporary changes for pedestrians and cyclists when we're working next to footpaths and at the station entrance. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to assist.

We will be removing ten car parking spaces on Railway Parade opposite Alexander Crescent from **7am on Monday 2 June until late 2026** to facilitate safe construction in the area.

Alternative parking is available at the council commuter car park on Railway Parade.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community by:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.
- Providing traffic controllers or signage to direct pedestrians.
