

# Night work on Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway and James Erskine Drive during March 2025

## **Mamre Road upgrade**

March 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people of the Tharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road, Erskine Park to reduce congestion and improve safety and travel times.

## What work are we doing this month?

We will continue to work at night for up to 21 shifts between Saturday 1 March and Monday 31 March along Mamre Road between the M4 Motorway, St Clair and Erskine Park Road. Erskine Park.

Our night work activities will include:

- installing, relocation and investigating utilities and stormwater drainage
- removing trees and vegetation within work areas
- removing, repairing and installing road surfaces
- water trucks spraying to reduce dust on site
- delivering, using and removing equipment from work areas and site compounds/stockpile yards as needed

Before we begin working at night, we will let nearby residents know the specific dates.

# Upcoming day work activities

Other work activities will continue during standard construction hours. You may see us on site:

- investigating, locating and marking where underground utility services are located
- relocating water, sewer, electricity, gas and telecommunications infrastructure
- survey and site investigation work

- importing and stockpiling material for construction work
- carrying out bulk earthwork
- constructing temporary and permanent road surfaces and access roads
- saw cutting and removing existing road surface, kerbs, and islands
- removing old and installing new line marking.

#### Our work schedule

We will need to do some work at night to maintain safety for road users and workers, and to keep people moving during peak travel times.

Our night shift hours will be from **6pm to 7am**, between **Monday night and Saturday morning**. We will work no more than two consecutive nights, a maximum of three nights per week, and no more than 10 nights per month at the same location. A map showing our work area is provided on the next page.

Where possible, we will work during the day, from 7am to 6pm between Monday and Friday, and from 8am to 1pm on Saturday. There will be no work on Sundays or public holidays.

#### What will this mean for you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impacts to nearby residents by:

- arranging the work in stages at different locations
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- directing lighting towers away from properties when working at night.



#### What equipment will we use?

During the work, we may use excavators, graders, rollers, bobcats, backhoes, mobile cranes, boring rigs, light and heavy vehicles, hand power tools, vacuum trucks, water carts, sweepers, road saws, elevated working platforms, chainsaws, lighting towers, asphalt pavers, traffic barrier installation equipment, generators, welders and metal cutting equipment.

#### Traffic changes

There will be lane closures in place along Mamre Road during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
