What work are we doing?

We will be replacing concrete pavement slabs on the northbound entry ramp to the Hume Highway from Medway Road at Marulan.

Work will be carried out from **Monday 29 April to Wednesday 8 May** between 7am and 5pm, weather permitting. No work will be carried out on Saturday or Sunday.

How will this work affect you?

There will be noise and lighting associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise and complete this work as quickly as possible.

Traffic impacts

From Monday 29 April to Friday 3 May and from Monday 6 May to Wednesday 8 May the northbound entry ramp to the Hume Highway from Medway Road will be closed. Northbound traffic will be detoured via George Street and Brayton Road to the Hume Highway.

The northbound entry ramp to the Hume Highway from Medway Road will re-open on **Saturday 4 May and Sunday 5 May.**

From **Monday 29 April to Thursday 2 May** guidance under traffic control and stop/slow conditions will be in place at the George Street and Medway Road roundabout.

For the safety of workers and motorists, a reduced speed limit of 80 km/h will be in place on the Hume Highway approaching the Medway Road intersection.


Road users are advised to allow five minutes additional travel time.
