



Repair work on the Hume Highway at Marulan from Monday 17 March

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

What work are we doing?

We will be replacing the most damaged concrete road slabs on a 1.1-kilometre section of the northbound lanes on the Hume Highway at Marulan, from Marulan South Road.

The most damaged concrete slabs in the first 600 metre section of this work will be replaced with asphalt. The damaged slabs in the remaining 500 metres of work will be replaced with concrete.

This work will improve safety and provide smoother journeys for road users.

When we will be working

Work will be carried out from **Monday 17 March to Thursday 10 April between 7am and 7pm, Monday to Saturday. Work will continue at night from 7pm to 6am, Sunday to Thursday nights only**, weather permitting.

How will this work affect you?

There will be temporary impacts to residents and motorists while we carry out this work.

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- road access changes, lane closures and reduced speed limits
- noise from machinery and equipment.

We will make every effort to minimise our impacts and complete this work as quickly as possible.

Traffic impacts

During work, northbound traffic will be diverted onto southbound lanes under contraflow traffic arrangements 24 hours a day until work is complete.

A reduced speed limit of 80 km/h will also be in place and road users should allow up to five minutes' additional travel time.

Vehicles travelling northbound and requiring access to Jerrara Road and Marulan South Road from the Hume Highway will be detoured via Brayton Road, and should allow up to 10 minutes' additional travel time.

Vehicles requiring northbound access to the Hume Highway from Jerrara Road and Marulan South Road will be detoured via Munro Road, and should allow up to five minutes' additional travel time.

Southbound access to and from Jerrara Road and Marulan South Road will remain unaffected.

Over size over mass vehicles (OSOM) wider than 3.2 metres will be required to use the designated pullover areas and contact UHF channel 24 to arrange access through the work area.

Access to and from the Boral and Holcim quarries at this location will be maintained in both directions at all times under the direction of traffic control.
