



Mona Vale Road West Upgrade

Survey and utility investigation works

April 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the Northern Beaches on which we work and pay respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is upgrading Mona Vale Road between Terry Hills and Ingleside, from two lanes to four lanes to ease congestion, reduce travel time and improve safety.

Transport for NSW acknowledges it has been sometime since you would have received information about the project.

In June 2024, funding was allocated to further develop the project's detailed design which has been progressing.

To inform the detailed design and planning for the project's delivery, Transport will be doing additional survey and utility investigation work.

What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out survey and utility investigation work along the Mona Vale Road corridor between McCarrs Creek Road, Terry Hills and Powderworks Road, Ingleside.

Work includes:

- establishing temporary work sites
- locating and verifying existing above ground and underground services
- digging small trenches in the ground
- restoring the work area when our investigations are finished.

When and where we'll be working

The investigation work will be carried out from **30 April to 1 August 2025** during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 6pm Saturdays**.

Some work may be required out of hours to minimise impacts to traffic and/or for the safety of workers and community. Impacted community will be notified before work commences.

The work will take place on:

- Mona Vale Road between McCarrs Creek Road, Terry Hills and Powderworks Road, Ingleside.
- McCarrs Creek Road and Kanangra Avenue, Terry Hills.
- Wirreanda Road, Tumburra Street, Addison Road, Bungendore Street and Harvey Road, Ingleside.

What will this mean for you?

During this work you may notice:

- increased presence of workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- temporary lane closures and reduced speeds
- noise from machinery and equipment such as small trucks, concrete saws, generators, hand tools and vacuum trucks.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- completing work during standard construction hours where possible
- installing noise blankets around work sites where required
- maintaining access at all times to properties and local roads
- turning off vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during this work including lane closures which may affect travel times. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the directions of traffic control and signs.

We remain committed to minimising impact wherever possible.

Next steps

Transport will continue to engage with affected property owners and stakeholders as designs progress.

Following the completion of design and investigation work, the NSW Government will be able to make a formal investment decision which will determine the project's final scope and cost.
