



Mortdale Maintenance Centre Access Road Upgrade

The Rail Service Improvement Program enables a safer, more equitable, and integrated transport network where people can move safely, reliably and efficiently across NSW.

Access road upgrade now complete

The new access road and associated improvements for Mortdale Maintenance Centre is now complete.

This will allow heavy vehicles safer and easier access to the maintenance centre.

Over the last year, the project has completed:

- A new 260-metre access road and new gate system
- A waiting bay allowing vehicles to stop safely while waiting to enter the centre
- A total 55 metres of retaining wall
- Installation of additional CCTV cameras and upgraded lighting systems
- Relocation of existing underground services
- Pedestrian and other safety upgrades inside the maintenance centre including installation of safe pedestrian crossings, bollards, signage and line marking.

We would like to thank the Oatley and Mortdale community, Oatley Senior Citizens Centre, Georges River Council and other stakeholders for their patience while we delivered this important work.

This completes a series of upgrades to Mortdale Maintenance Centre starting in 2020 which has delivered:

- A new bogie exchange system inside the maintenance centre, enabling train wheels to be automatically removed from carriages and transported for maintenance
- A new electrical substation
- Upgraded site sheds to allow more efficient maintenance work
- Track modifications, drainage upgrades, new retaining walls and electrical work
- An upgraded access road off Oatley Avenue, east of the maintenance centre.
