# Landslip repairs continue on Cambewarra Mountain

# Natural disaster recovery

July 2025







Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will begin natural disaster recovery work at two sites on Moss Vale Road at Cambewarra Mountain from next week.

Since 2022, 37 landslip sites have been repaired on Moss Vale Road, with work at a further 13 sites to begin.

The landslip damage was caused by a series of unprecedented natural disaster events that brought record-breaking rainfall - up to six times the average rainfall totals, in some cases.

## What work are we doing?

Slope stabilisation work will be carried out at two landslip sites on the eastern side of Cambewarra Mountain.

#### Work includes:

- establishing a temporary work site
- · clearing debris and vegetation
- drilling long steels rods into the slope (known as soils nails)
- applying heavy-duty mesh or spraying concrete (known as shotcrete)
- improving drainage
- · resurfacing and line marking the road.

### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working at the first site, located one kilometre north of Barfield Road, from **Sunday 6 July 2025 for around four weeks,** weather permitting.

Site set up will begin from 7pm Sunday 6 July, however our standard working days will be Monday to Friday.

After work at the first site is complete, workers will move slightly south to the second site, around 750 metres north of Barfield Road.

Work at this site will begin in **early August** and is expected to be completed by the end of the August, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be **6am to 6pm, Monday to Friday.** 

On occasion, work outside of standard hours may be required, such as on Saturdays or at night. The community will be informed in advance if work outside of standard hours is required.

## What will this mean for you?

There will be temporary impacts while we carry out this work. We'll make every effort to minimise our impacts and complete this work as quickly as possible.

#### You may notice:

- · workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closure and reduced speed limit of 40 km/h
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Motorists using Moss Vale Road will experience short delays, with one lane closed to allow safe access to the landslip sites. Motorists are advised to allow an additional five minutes' travel time.
