


Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community notification

May 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to make the station more accessible and to accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet.

The project will achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance, providing a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with the community's transport needs.

What work are we doing?

Over the next month, we will continue carrying out construction and landscaping activities in and around the station and stabling yard, as well as on Argyle Street, Lackey Road and Dalys Way.

During this period we will:

- continue working within the Station Master's office, with access available via the door next to the station entrance
- continue installing new automated doors for the waiting room, luggage room and station office
- carry out work on the pedestrian crossing on Lackey Road
- continue working on the stabling yard power supply and refuelling bay
- install sound wall panels at the stabling yard.

What does this mean for you?


As part of this work:

- there will be no vehicle or pedestrian access along Dalys Way, and no pedestrian access via the Lackey Road footbridge
- Dalys Way will remain closed to vehicles for about two months, with pedestrian access expected to be reinstated earlier. The Lackey Road footbridge will remain closed until about the end of June
- all buses will arrive and depart on Argyle Street near Leighton Gardens
- the original station entrance has been reopened and is accessible via the pathways on either side of the waiting room
- Lackey Road will have intermittent traffic control with some temporary lane closures to enable the safe delivery of the sound wall panels, and for work at the stabling yard to be carried out safely.

When will we be working?

Most work will take place during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.







The new Argyle Street footbridge lifts officially welcomed their first passenger on Thursday 17 April, marking a key milestone in improving station accessibility.

Out-of-hours work

We will be working from **6am to 6pm on Saturday 17 May**. For the safety of staff and passengers, this work will take place during a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period when no trains are running, and the station is closed.

Temporary closure of Lackey Road footbridge

The Lackey Road footbridge and Dalys Way are now closed to vehicles and pedestrians to enable accessibility upgrades in this area. **Until they are reopened, access to the station is limited to the Argyle Street footbridge and lifts.**

Shuttle bus service

A free return shuttle bus service will run between Lackey Road/Garrett Street and Argyle Street (near Leighton Gardens) every 15 minutes. This service will be in place Mondays to Fridays between:

- 6am and 9am
- 3pm and 6pm
