



Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community notification

August 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to make the station more accessible and to accommodate the new Regional Rail Fleet.

The project will achieve Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance, providing a station precinct that is accessible to people with disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with the community's transport needs.

What work are we doing?

We are approaching completion of the station buildings, forecourt, Dalys Way and the Lackey Road footbridge and lift.

Over the next month we will be:

- Continuing construction of the lift and pedestrian crossing on Lackey Road
- Demobilising the site compound and installing parking next to the commuter car park
- Finalising line marking for parking, kiss and ride, and taxi zones
- Completing bicycle rack and signage along Dalys Way and at the station entrance.

Activities at the stabling yard will include:

- Working on the high voltage power upgrade
- Installing additional track
- Carrying out trenching and construction work.

What will this mean for you?

- After the opening event on **Saturday 26 July**, full pedestrian and vehicle access along Dalys Way will be restored, and the Lackey Road footbridge and lift will be fully operational.
- Regional buses will return to the station entrance from **Monday 28 July**.

When and where we'll be working

Construction activities will take place along Dalys Way, Lackey Road and the stabling yard.

Work will be carried out during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**.

Traffic changes

Intermittent traffic control will continue on Lackey Road, including some partial lane closures to enable deliveries to the stabling yard.

Lackey Road will be closed between Garrett Street and Parks Road on **Monday 11 August**. Traffic will be detoured via Parkes Steet. Residents will have access to their properties.

Full details will be provided in an upcoming special notice.





Refurbishment and landscaping have started around the Governor's Platform, originally used in the early 1900s when the governor travelled to his country residence at Sutton Forest near Moss Vale.

Come and celebrate with us

The Moss Vale community is invited to celebrate the completion of safety and accessibility upgrades at Moss Vale Station from 11am on **Saturday 26 July**. The celebration will include an official opening, plaque unveiling, sausage sizzle and will coincide with the picnic steam train stopping at the station.

Work at the stabling yard will continue as normal.
