



Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community Notification

October/November 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gundungurra people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to make the station more accessible and to accommodate the new Regional Rail Fleet.

The Moss Vale Station upgrade is now complete, achieving Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance, providing a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with the community's transport needs.

While the station is now open, there may be minor work carried out in this area as required.

What work are we doing?

Throughout October and November, work in the stabling yard area will include:

- upgrades to the staff car park area, including kerbing and guttering
- weatherproofing joints in paved areas
- electrical work, including final testing of new CCTV systems

From **Monday 20 October**, crews will begin de-mobilising the temporary stabling yard site opposite Platform 1 at Moss Vale Station. Work will include the removal of all the barbed wire from fencing on Lackey Road, as well as temporary containment, walkways and materials from site.

What will this mean for you?

- The first stage of the upgraded stabling yard is expected to be completed later this month. Once complete, all trains will stable in the new facility.
- In early November, the Argyle Street commuter car park will be closed for one day only to allow for new line markings to be installed.
- From mid-November, a section of the commuter car park at the top of Dalys Way will undergo resurfacing. Some parking spaces will be temporarily unavailable during this time to allow for work to be carried out safely.

Signage will be installed in advance of any temporary parking impacts.

When and where we'll be working

Most work will take place within the stabling yard area during normal working hours **7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**.

Potential weekend work may also be required in the stabling yard on **Saturday 15 November 2025**. For the safety of staff and the community, this work will coincide with a scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork period, when no trains are running and the station is closed.

All work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.
