Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard Upgrade

Community notification

September 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is investing in an upgrade to Moss Vale Station and Stabling Yard to make the station more accessible and to accommodate the new Regional Rail fleet.

The Moss Vale Station upgrade is now complete, achieving Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002 (DSAPT) compliance and providing a station precinct that is accessible to those with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage, while ensuring it aligns with the community's transport needs.

What work are we doing?

While the station is now open, there may be minor work carried out from time to time in these areas. Work will continue this month at the stabling yard including:

- installing the final section of the noise wall at the northern end of the stabling yard
- finalising installation of footpaths and accessways within the rail corridor, as well as a staff car park and amenities
- reinstatement works to the asphalt in the Dalys Way top commuter car park

When and where we'll be working

Work will take place at the stabling yard during standard construction hours from **7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday.**

What will this mean for you?

Expect heavy vehicle movements near the intersection of Parkes Road and Lackey Road, with intermittent lane closures.

Lackey Road will continue to have intermittent traffic control, including some temporary lane closures, to enable the delivery of new track for the upgraded stabling yard.

13 car parking spaces in the Dalys Way top commuter car park will be unavailable for two days in early to mid-September.
