Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Mulgoa Road Upgrade between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

What work are we doing?

We will be working on Mulgoa Road, at the corner of side streets and the M4 ramps between **6pm and 7am**.

The map overleaf shows the locations of the work.

Work will include:

investigating, building and maintaining road surfaces

- investigating and installing utilities and drainage and switching over to new utilities
- creating trenches for electrical utilities
- piling to install traffic light equipment
- restoring the site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work.

In the event of inclement weather or operational issues, we will work on **30 April**, **2 and 7 May**.



Traffic changes

The M4 westbound on and off ramps, as well as the eastbound off-ramp, will be closed from 8pm to 5am on 5, 6 and 8 May. Road users are advised to use a detour route via the Russell Street ramps or the Northern Road ramps to access the M4 during the closures.

There will be lane and road closures during night work along Mulgoa Road.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs, plan ahead and allow for extra travel time.

What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use. We aim to complete the louder work before midnight however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while we complete this important work.
