Transport for NSW is continuing work on Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

# What work are we doing?

We will be working on Mulgoa Road at the corner of side streets, and the M4 ramps between **6pm and 7am**.

The map on the next page shows the work locations.

#### Work includes:

- investigating, removing, building and maintaining road surfaces
- investigating and installing new utilities and drainage
- switching over to new utilities
- removing barriers

restoring site when work is finished.

The stockpile site at 95 Blaikie Road will be used during this work.

In case of bad weather or operational issues, we will work on Wednesday 18, Friday 20 and Wednesday 25 June 2025.

### Traffic changes

The northbound right turn lane onto the M4 eastbound on ramp will be closed **on Monday 16**, **Tuesday 17**, **Thursday 19**, **Monday 23**, **Tuesday 24**, **and Thursday 26 June 2025**, **between 7pm and 6am**. Please detour by continuing down Mulgoa Road and use the Great Western Highway or the Northern Road to access the M4.



The M4 eastbound and westbound off ramps will be closed on Monday 23 and Tuesday 24 June 2025, between 8pm and 5am. Please detour via the Northern Road or Russell Street to access the M4.

Night work along Mulgoa Road will include lane and road closures. Please observe speed limits, follow the directions of traffic controllers and signs, plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

# What will this mean for you?

While our work may be noisy at times, we will do everything we can to minimise the impact including turning off machinery when it's not in use. We aim to complete the noisier work before midnight however, some intermittent noise may occur after midnight.

You may hear sounds like squawking from reversing trucks or see flashing lights as we work to restore the site. These are essential to maintain safe work practices.
