

New bus services for Western Sydney

August 2025



New bus services will connect Campbelltown, Liverpool and Leppington, as well as Penrith and Mt Druitt, to the new Western Sydney International Airport and Bradfield City Centre.

Bus services will start before the Western Sydney International Airport opens in 2026 to support growth across Western Sydney.

Five new bus routes and one enhanced route will connect employment, health, education, and retail hubs to provide a sustainable transport alternative for the people of Western Sydney.



New integrated transport network in Western Sydney


Transport for NSW is building a safe, easy-to-use transport network for the people of Western Sydney.

Work is well underway with The Northern Road and Bringelly Road upgrades complete and the toll-free M12 Motorway opening in 2026.


To support the new bus services, we will do some work to improve the road surface along Badgerys Creek Road to handle increased heavy vehicle use.

We will continue to review bus services as demand increases across the region.

One new bus service and one enhanced route from Campbelltown.

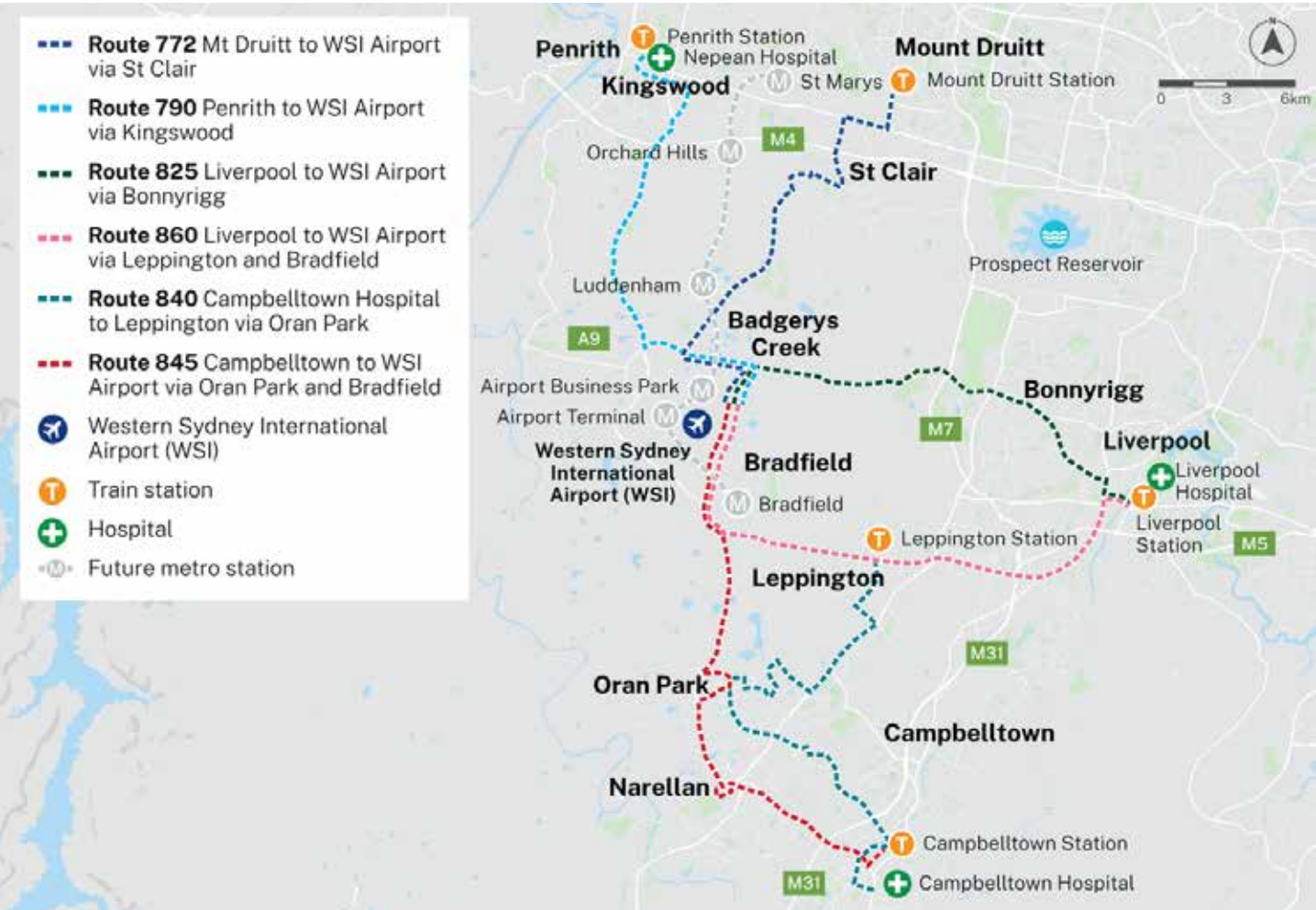
- Both bus routes will serve Oran Park.
- Route 845 will go via the centre of Narellan, direct to the Airport Precinct.
- Route 840 will bypass Narellan to Leppington, where passengers can change to other bus services to the Airport Precinct or Liverpool, as well as the Sydney Trains network.

New bus services from Penrith will provide more connections to Nepean Hospital.

New bus services for Western Sydney



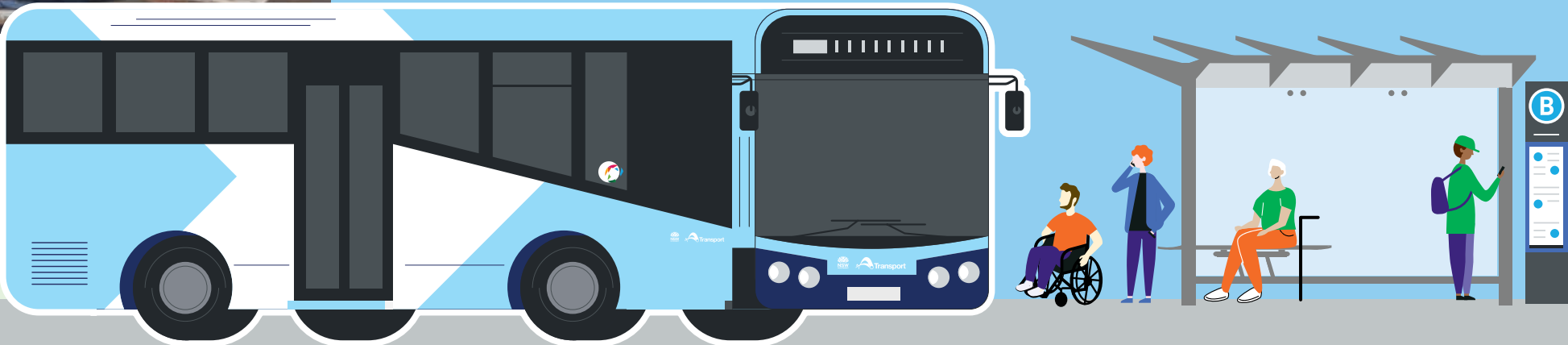

| Penrith CBD to Nepean Hospital | 10 minutes |
| Casula to Leppington Station | 20 minutes |
| Oran Park to Campbelltown | 25 minutes |
| Campbelltown to Narellan | 15 minutes |
| Narellan to Oran Park | 15 minutes |

New services will use existing roads so they are running as soon as possible. This includes the new bus lanes and infrastructure built during The Northern Road Upgrade.

| Campbelltown to WSI Airport, via Oran Park and Bradfield | 66 minutes |

| Liverpool to WSI Airport, via Leppington and Bradfield | 55 minutes |
| Campbelltown Hospital to Leppington, via Oran Park (enhanced existing route 840 and 858) | 66 minutes |

The bus fleet servicing the new bus routes will include modern electric buses. These will provide a quieter, smoother and more comfortable ride for passengers, and support the NSW Government's goal of net zero emissions by 2050. Existing depots will be upgraded to cater for the electric buses.

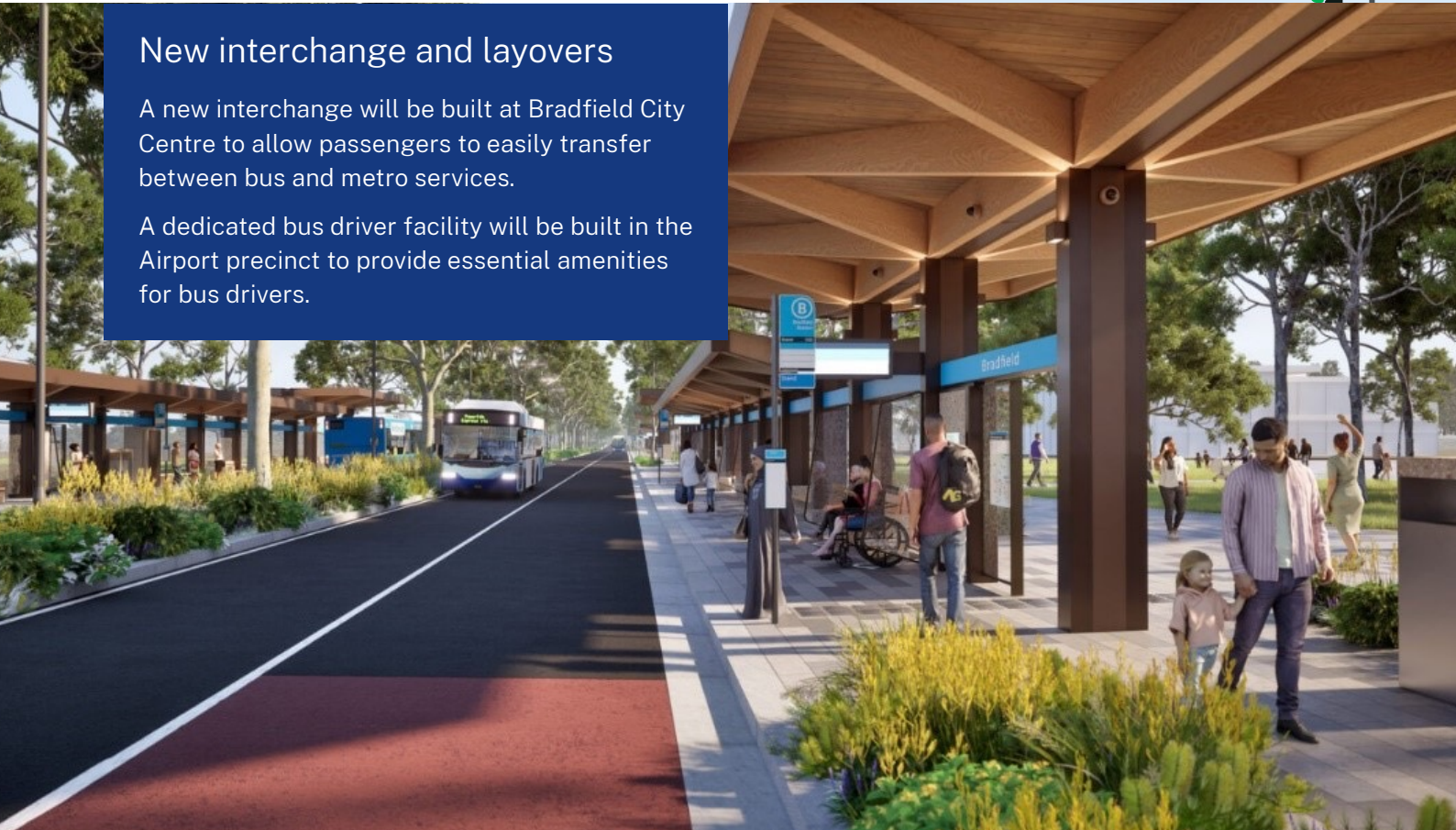

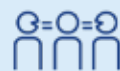
