To accommodate the new intercity (Mariyung) fleet, we need to upgrade and modify some existing rail infrastructure at various locations across the rail network.


### What does this mean for you?

From **Monday 12 May** to **Friday 23 May 2025**, material and equipment deliveries may occur outside standard construction hours, at the laydown area within the rail corridor at **Ourimbah Station**. See the map overleaf.

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**, and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

The delivery activities have been assessed and will be monitored, however it is not expected to be noticeable.
