



Safety improvement work at the intersection of Pacific Parade and The Crescent, Dee Why from Thursday 5 June 2025

Community Notification

May 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Traditional Custodians of the Northern Beaches on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is improving pedestrian and road safety at the intersection of Pacific Parade and The Crescent, Dee Why. This work is being completed as part of the Road Safety Program.

Work will start from **Thursday 5 June** and be completed by **Friday 18 July 2025**.

Road Safety Program

The Road Safety Program aims to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads. This includes the Pedestrian Protection Sub-Program, which aims to improve protection for vulnerable road users, particularly on urban footpaths, shared pathways, cycleways and road crossings.

Since 2020, the Australian and NSW Governments have invested more than \$500 million into road safety projects across NSW.

What work are we doing?

To improve pedestrian and road safety at the intersection we will:

- reduce the two westbound lanes on Pacific Parade approach to the intersection to one lane to create an indented bus area for Pacific Parade bus stop (Stop ID 209972)
- install a signalised pedestrian crossing across The Crescent to allow pedestrians to more safely cross the road while holding motorists on red arrows.

Work activities will include:

- widening the footpath area on the southeast corner of the intersection to create the indented bus area
- installing new traffic light poles and adding left turn arrow lanterns
- installing new kerbs to improve accessibility for pedestrians with mobility issues and parents with prams
- installing traffic light cabling under the footpath and road surface.

To install the traffic light cabling, we will need to excavate sections of the footpath and road surface. These sections will be temporarily filled in after each shift and permanently restored before the project is completed.

When will we be working?

We will be on site for up to **19 night shifts** between **Thursday 5 June** and **Friday 18 July**, weather permitting.

We will work between **Sunday** and **Thursday, 8pm** and **5am**, the next day.

We will not work on Friday nights, Saturdays or on the Monday 9 June public holiday.

We will work up to **five nights a week** to complete this work as quickly as possible, to minimise impact to the community.



What will this mean for you and how will we manage it?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
 - completing noisier tasks by midnight
 - installing noise blankets around our work area when carrying out noisy activities
 - using quieter equipment where possible.
- If you have any concerns about our work activities

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe.

Location of work area – Pacific Parade and The Crescent, Dee Why

This will include lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

Access to the pedestrian crossing and footpath will be maintained under the guidance of traffic controllers. Temporary traffic lights will also be used while we install the new lanterns.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
