


Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road upgrade, Carlingford

Community update

May 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Burramattagal people of the Dharug Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading the intersection of Pennant Hills Road and North Rocks Road, Carlingford to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety for road users.

The project is being delivered as part of the NSW Government's \$450 million Urban Roads Congestion Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney's busiest corridors.

When will we be working?

Between 1 June 2025 and 31 August 2025 work will be carried out during our standard working hours from Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday, 8am to 1pm.

Out of hours work will also be required for up to **five nights each week**, from **Sunday** to **Thursday between 8pm and 5am the next day**. We will not work on weekends between 1pm Saturday and 8pm Sunday.

What work will we continue doing?

Between 1 June and 31 August 2025, we will be carrying out:

- investigation works on existing underground service locations
- property adjustment works
- demolition and road realignment work within the road corridors
- traffic signal, civil and utility adjustment works
- compound operations and plant movement will continue at 728 and 685 Pennant Hills Road.

Ongoing asbestos removal

Transport for NSW works with qualified asbestos professionals, such as licensed asbestos removalists and Licensed Asbestos Assessors, to safely manage and remove asbestos from project sites and dispose of any asbestos waste to a licensed waste facility.

If, during construction, asbestos not previously identified is found, work will immediately stop while asbestos materials are further assessed and safely removed.

How will the work affect you?

While we carry out our work you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise and vibration from machinery
- temporary traffic changes, including lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.



Temporary footpath closures

Until July 2026:

- the footpath on the southern side of North Rocks Road between the intersection with Pennant Hills Road and Jenkins Road is closed. Please use the footpath on the northern side of North Rocks Road
- the footpath on the eastern side of Pennant Hills Road between the intersection with North Rocks Road and Roselea Community Centre is closed. Please use the footpath on the western side of Pennant Hills Road.


Access to pedestrian crossings will be always maintained. Follow the signage showing the pedestrian detours in place.

Managing our impacts

We aim to reduce community impacts by:

- fencing our work site for safety and security
- using quieter equipment where possible
- turning off equipment when not in use
- completing noisier activities like mulching, saw cutting and jackhammering by midnight where possible - in instances where noisy work is required past midnight, you will be notified in advance
- directing construction lighting to avoid excess glare or light into neighbouring properties.
