Planning a future bypass of Picton town centre

Transport for NSW will be investigating the area around the proposed future Picton Bypass, to help inform project planning. This work will include Picton Road and Remembrance Driveway.

What work are we doing?

We are doing ground investigations to help with the design and construction planning for Picton Bypass.

Work includes:

- Drilling bore holes and test pits to check the ground
- Restoring disturbed areas, such as filling pits
- Locating existing underground pipes or cables
- Using drones to film the study area
- Checking soil samples to understand the ground conditions

When and where we'll be working

We will work for 12 weeks, starting 16 June 2025.

Work hours:

- **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday**
- **Night shifts - 6pm to 7am (approximately 10 night shifts along Remembrance Driveway and Picton Road), with no loud work after 11pm.**

Night shifts will not take place on more than two consecutive nights in any one location.

What will this mean for you?

A 40km/h speed limit will be in place on Picton Road and Remembrance Driveway at night to keep road users and workers safe. Please follow the speed limit and obey traffic controllers and signs.

You may notice:

- Some noise from vehicles and equipment
- Possible dust in the area

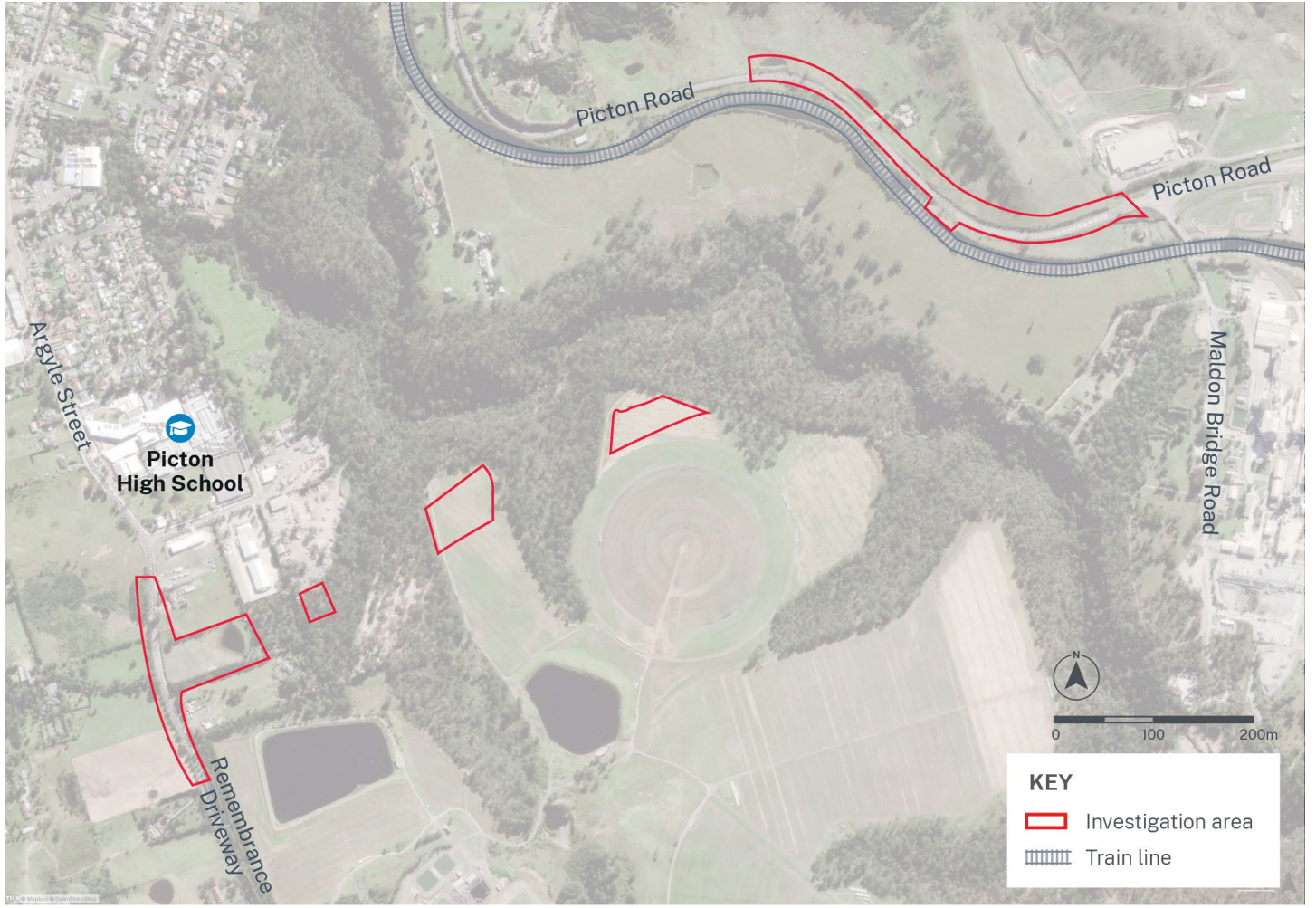
Managing our impacts

We manage our work to reduce impacts on the community and environment. During our work:

- Property access remains open
- Equipment and vehicles will be turned off when not in use to reduce noise
- Areas will be watered down to manage dust
- Lights will be directed away from residents where possible
- Work areas will be kept clean and clear of rubbish
- We will prevent dirty water from entering drainage lines or waterways
