

Early work on Pitt Town Bypass from 12 May 2025

Community Notification

May 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug and Gundungarra People as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building the Pitt Town Bypass to take traffic, including heavy vehicles out of the town centre. This will make travel quicker and safer for all road users.

What work are we doing?

Small work crews will be on site doing early preparation work for the site compound including:

- surveying existing utilities
- ground condition surveys and land assessments
- geotechnical investigations
- bringing in materials to set up the site compound
- setting up construction equipment
- getting ready to build the new site compound at 42 Wellesley Street
- fixing up 51 & 54 Wellesley Street to use as site office locations
- installing project signs and temporary traffic barriers.

When and where we'll be working

We will work at our site compound location at the end of Wellesley Street and in various site areas in Pitt Town. Please see a map on the next page for our work locations.

The work will take place between **Monday 12 May and Wednesday 30 July 2025, weather permitting.**

For this early work, we will only be working during the day. Our working hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday**, and between **8am and 1pm Saturdays**.

We will not work on Sundays or any public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

When we are working, you may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- noise from machinery and equipment.
- traffic controllers and signs
- reduced speed limits

Equipment we will use during this early work will include vacuum trucks, core drills, saw cutters, traffic control trucks, survey equipment, trucks and light vehicles.

Managing our impacts

We will manage our work to limit impacts to the community, residents and the environment.

This includes:

- ensuring the community can walk through and access their properties
- keeping dust under control
- removing waste
- turning off machinery when it is not being used.

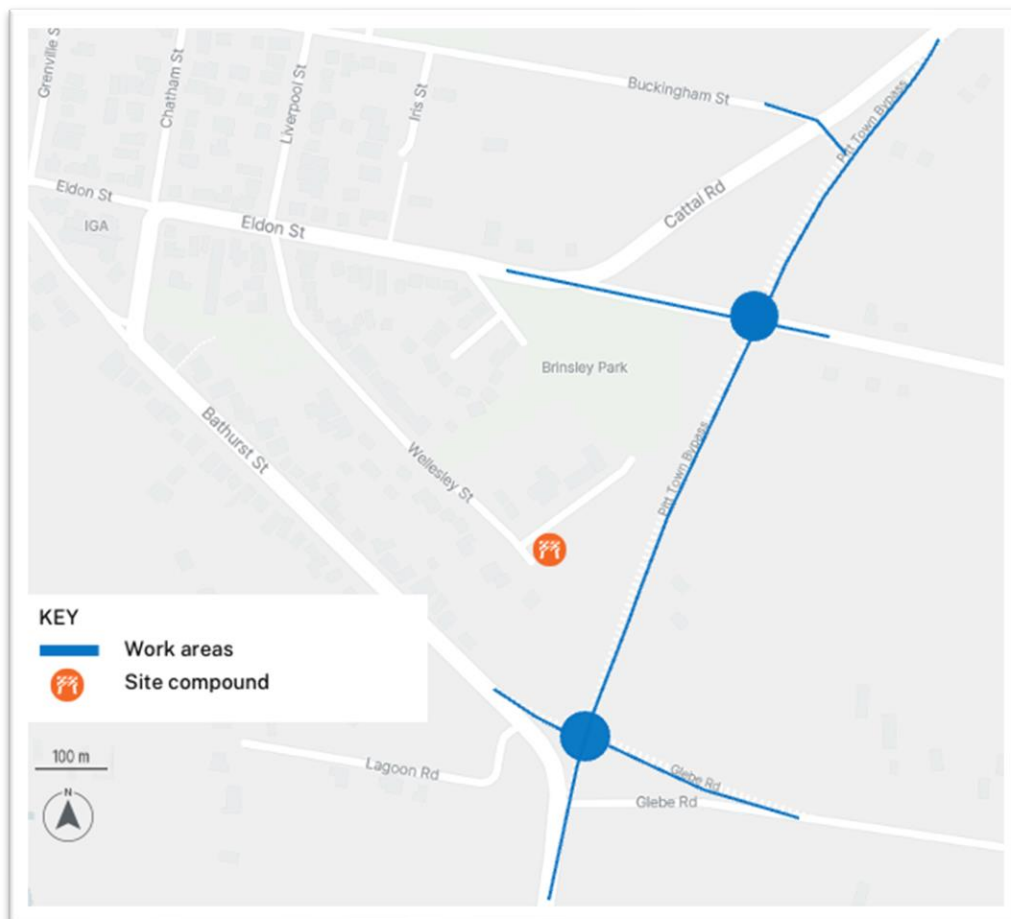


Traffic and pedestrian impacts

There will be temporary traffic changes while we complete this work. These changes may include closing lanes reducing the speed limit to 40km/h to increase safety for road users and our workers.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
