

Night work on Pitt Town Road and Glebe Road, Pitt Town from Wednesday 8 October 2025

Community Notification

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug and Gundungarra peoples as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is building the Pitt Town bypass to take traffic, including heavy vehicles out of the town centre. This will make travel safer and more efficient for all road users.

The project has identified that you may be impacted by upcoming night work.

Alternative accommodation will be offered via a separate letter to properties where noise levels are expected to exceed 25 dBA above the usual nighttime noise.

What work are we doing?

Work includes:

- installing and relocating utilities
- trenching and excavating
- backfilling, compacting, and reinstating impacted ground surfaces
- utility switch overs.

When and where we'll be working

We will need to work **15 night shifts** between **Wednesday 8 October** and **Tuesday 28 October 2025**, weather permitting.

Our working hours will be between **7pm and 5am Monday to Friday**. We will be working on sections of Pitt Town Road, Glebe Road and Old Pitt Town Road.

What will this mean for you?

Utility relocations are required as part of our construction of the Pitt Town bypass. This work needs to be done at night to reduce traffic disruptions and for the safety of our workers and other road users. While we work, you will notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signs
- temporary lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Equipment we will use for this work includes:

- traffic barriers, signs and VMS boards
- generators and lighting towers
- vacuum trucks, concrete trucks and drill rigs
- smooth drum rollers and compactors
- excavators, semi-trailers, tipper trucks and light vehicles
- water carts

Traffic impacts

There will be temporary traffic impacts while we complete this work. This includes lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

We will also use traffic control to help road users through the work area. Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

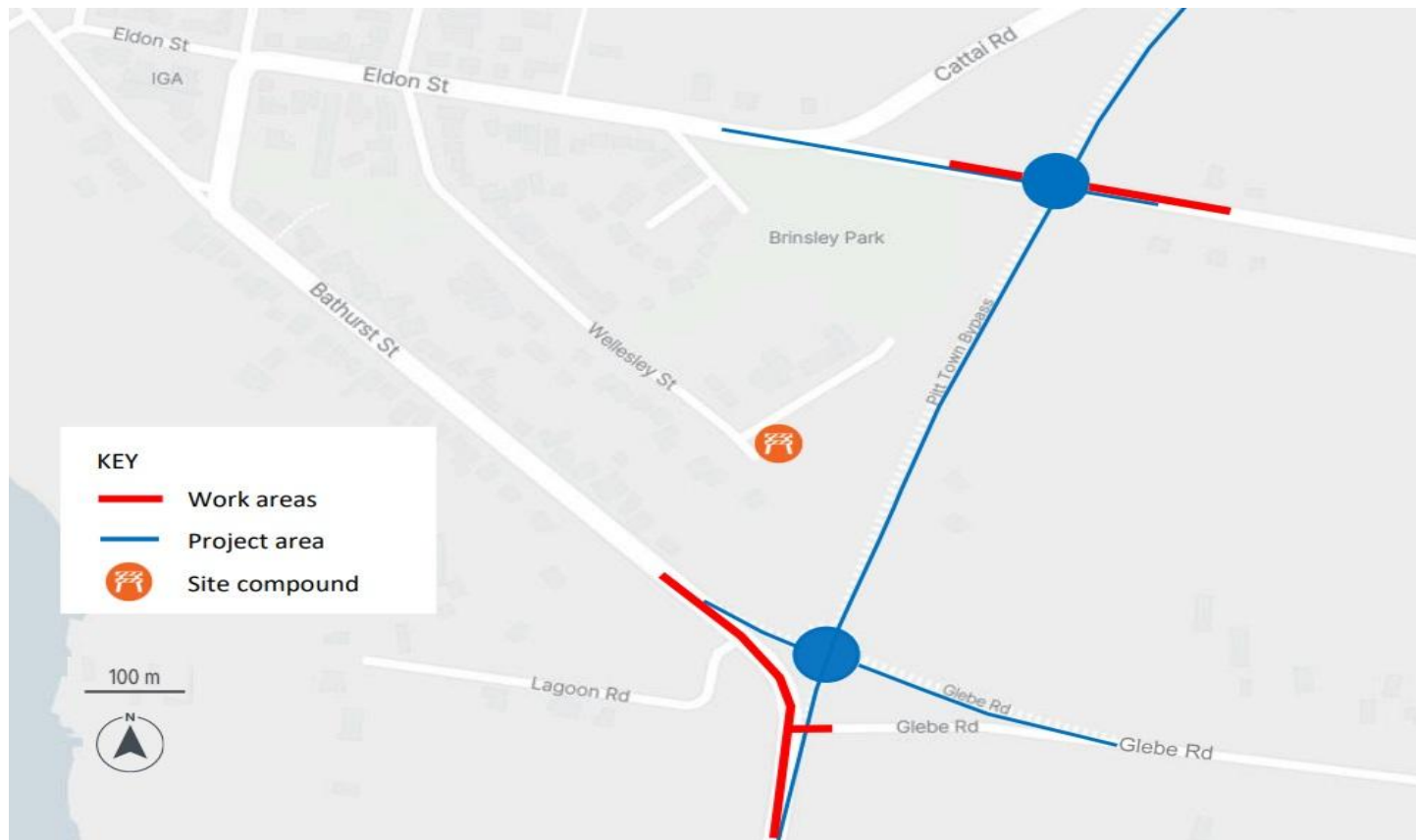


Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment by:

- completing noisy work activities by midnight where possible
- turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use
- using noise blankets to reduce noise where space allows
- speaking with directly affected residents.
