What will this mean for you ?

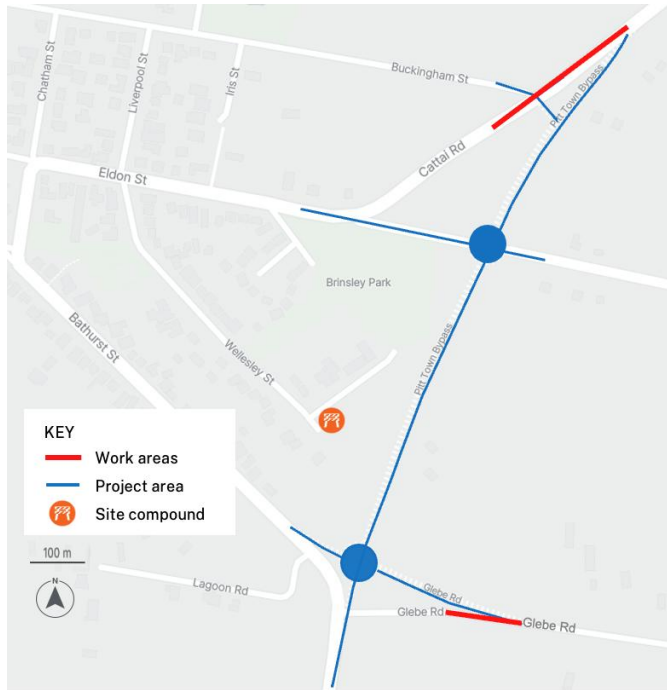
While we work, you will notice workers, vehicles and some noise from machinery and equipment. Temporary
