


Slope remediation work on Putty Road between Colo Heights and Mellong from 12 January 2025

Community Notification

January 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Darug Peoples of the Dharawal Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is carrying out pavement and slope repair work to strengthen the Putty Road.

This work will stabilise a slope damaged by flooding in 2022 on the Putty Road 10 kilometres north of Colo Heights.

What work are we doing?

We will be:

- creating temporary parking areas to limit plant movements to and from site
- installing safety barriers
- clearing vegetation where needed
- excavating pavement up to four metres deep to bedrock
- constructing a gabion basket retaining wall about five metres high and 35 metres long
- rebuilding road pavement and shoulder
- replacing the steel guardrail
- building new drainage, including around 640 metres of new stormwater pipes
- installing a new guardrail
- new line marking.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working for 29 weeks from **13 January to 31 July 2025**, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm on Saturday.**

We will not work on Sunday or public holidays.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- a material storage area, including a compound next to the work zone
- workers and vehicles
- traffic signage
- traffic controllers to guide heavy vehicle access on and off site when needed.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. These measures include:

- · minimising vegetation removal
- · fencing for safety and security
- separation of vehicle and pedestrian access
- reducing our noise as much as possible, including turning off plant and equipment when not in use
- protecting trees with no-go areas
- · erosion and sediment controls
- targeting lighting to minimise light spill
- replanting trees to replace those that needed to go, in accordance with the landscaping plan
- restoring the work site and laydown/stockpile area when all work is finished.

Traffic impacts

The south-bound kerb lane will be closed to facilitate the repairs, however the Putty Road will remain open in both directions while we work.

A reduced speed limit of 60km/h will be in place for the safety of workers and road users.

Static signs will inform people of truck movements.

Motorists are advised to plan ahead, drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
