


# Night work and temporary tow away zones along Carrington Road and Frenchmans Road, Randwick

# **Community notification**

April 2025





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will carry out essential road maintenance on Carrington Road and Frenchmans Road, Randwick from 7 May.

## What work are we doing?

This essential work will repair damage caused by the 2022 Sydney flood events. This includes removing potholes, cracks and uneven surfaces to deliver a safer, better quality and more durable road.

Our work includes removing and replacing sections of asphalt in both directions and repainting line markings. We'll also be repairing some kerbs and gutters as well as trimming some of the trees overhanging the road.

# When and where we'll be working

For the safety of road users, and to minimise traffic disruption, our work will take place at night in the following locations:

- Carrington Road, between Frenchmans Road and Darley Road, for four shifts between Wednesday 7 May and Sunday 15 June
- Frenchmans Road, between Avoca Street and Carrington Road, for ten shifts between Tuesday 13 May and Sunday 15 June

Please refer to the map overleaf. Exact dates are dependent on the weather.

Working hours are **8pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.** Work will not occur on Fridays, Saturdays, or public holidays.

## Temporary tow away zones, 6pm-6am, Sunday to Thursday – plan ahead

To ensure a high quality and long-lasting road surface, and to reduce the duration of work, temporary tow away zones will be implemented for this night work.

If vehicles are left in the work zone, we must work around them, resulting in that section of road not being repaired. This impacts the long-term durability of the road surface.

The tow away zones will be in place on both sides of the road from **6pm-6am**, **Sunday to Thursday**.

More information on specific dates will be provided on the tow away signage, website and reminder notices distributed to nearby properties.

Towing will commence at 6pm and vehicles still parked within the temporary tow zones will be towed to alternate available locations.

Residents and motorists are advised to follow the instructions on signage and to plan ahead.

Parking patrol crews will also be on site to provide guidance to motorists.

# Towing procedure

Tow away zones apply to everyone including residents with parking permits, businesses and Mobility Scheme permit holders.

Tow away signage will be installed at the work sites. Examples of the signs are shown below:









All vehicles that have been towed to another location will be registered with the Transport Management Centre (TMC), allowing vehicle owners to track their vehicle location.

Vehicle owners can find their vehicle by

- contacting the TMC on 131 700 to obtain a ticket number
- locate their towed vehicle through the 'Find My Car' portal

## Managing our impacts

We aim to reduce impacts as much as possible by:

- staging the work in different locations along the work alignment
- completing noisier tasks by midnight including saw cutting and jack hammering
- turning off equipment when not in use and positioning away from properties
- targeted lighting to minimise light
- stopping work where possible for respite periods.

We thank the community for your patience while we complete this work.

## Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will also be in place between 6pm and 6am while we are working and include:

- a work zone speed of 40 km/h and lane closures
- onsite traffic controllers providing guidance
- multiple variable messaging signs (VMS) to provide advanced notice of traffic changes
- restricted access to Frenchmans Road from Carrington Road for one night shift on 21 May Motorists will need to use adjacent roads and follow the instructions of onsite traffic controllers
- bus stops may be relocated slightly during work but bus services will not be impacted
- we will liaise directly with properties and businesses to discuss access arrangements during our work.
