Regional & Rural roadwork restrictions

Road access restrictions will be implemented during school holidays, public holiday long weekends and the Christmas/New Year period in 2025-2026.

No planned works including dynamic work are permitted to occur on all Regional & Rural principal corridors between the hours of 6 am and 8 pm during the following periods:

NSW autumn school holidays restrictions:

6 am Friday 11 April 2025 to Sunday 13 April 2025 (night shift permitted Sunday night)

Easter long weekend restrictions:

 6 am Thursday 17 April 2025 to Tuesday 22 April 2025 (night shift permitted Tuesday night)

Anzac Day long weekend restrictions (including school holidays):

Alpine restrictions begin:

Night work is permitted during the ROL restriction periods provided the work is undertaken between the hours of 8 pm and 6 am, does not exceed these times, the work site is continuously attended, and roadway conditions are returned to normal without traffic control or after-care.
