

Richmond Road, Knox Road and Quakers Hill Parkway intersection upgrade

Network Efficiency Program

November 2025



Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW will extend the right turn bays at the intersection of Richmond Road, Knox Road and Quakers Hill Parkway, Quakers Hill as part of the Network Efficiency Program.

The Network Efficiency Program aims to improve reliability and efficiency across the Sydney road network.

The work will reduce the likelihood of vehicles queuing out of the right turn bays and impacting the traffic flow on Richmond Road and Knox Road.

What work are we doing?

To improve traffic flow and ease congestion at the intersection, the right turn bays will be extended by between 40 and 85 metres at the following locations:

- Richmond Road onto Knox Road: from 80 metres to 265 metres
- Richmond Road onto Quakers Hill Parkway: from 85 metres to 195 metres
- Knox Road onto Richmond Road: from 40 metres to 90 metres.

Work activities will include:

- establishing a temporary work site
- using machinery to cut into the road and medians
- new pavement and asphalt resurfacing
- new line marking.

When and where we will be working

We will be on site for up to **90 night shifts** from **Sunday 9 November 2025** until **late March 2026**, weather permitting.

We will work up to five night shifts per week from **Sunday to Thursday**, between **8pm** and **5am**, the next day.

There will be no work on Friday or Saturday nights. We will additionally **not work between Friday 19 December 2025 and Sunday 4 January 2026**.

What will this mean for you and how will we manage it?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- installing noise blankets around our work when carrying out noisy activities
- turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- completing high-noise activities by midnight
- installing noise blankets around our work when carrying out high-noise activities
- using quieter equipment when possible.

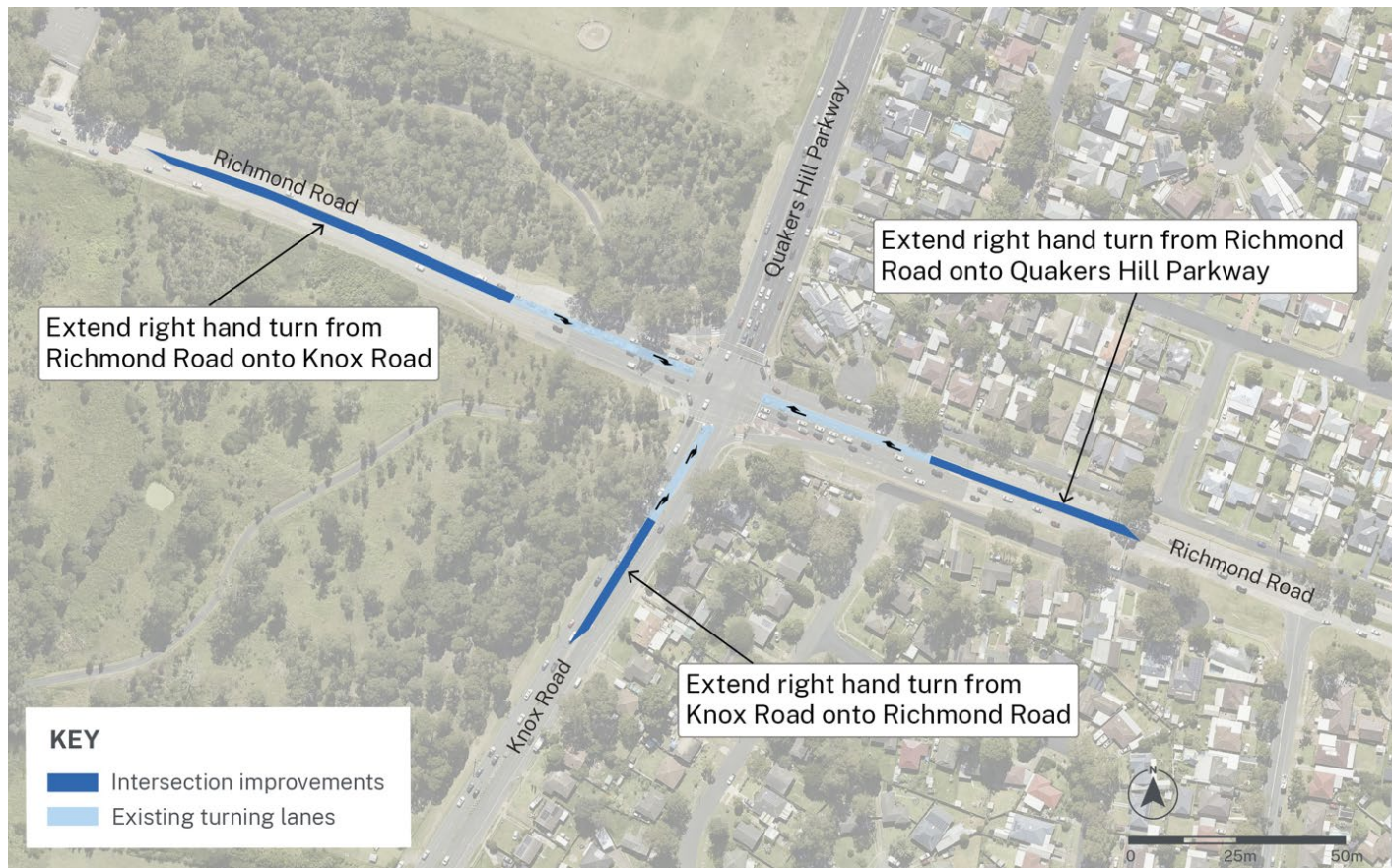
Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. This will include lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 60km/h.
