Safety improvement work at James Ruse Drive, Rosehill from 5 June

Road Safety Program

Transport for NSW will carry out safety improvements at James Ruse Drive. Rosehill.

The Road Safety Program, which was launched in early 2024, aims to improve safety and reduce crashes on NSW roads.

The Australian and NSW governments are investing \$518 million into road safety projects across NSW.

What work are we doing?

As part of this program, we will be resurfacing the road with high friction asphalt to create a safer road surface and improve vehicle traction.

We will also be repainting line markings.

When and where will we be working?

We will be working on northbound lanes at James Ruse Drive, between Virginia Street and Hassall Street, Rosehill for up to four night shifts between Thursday 5 June and Thursday 31 July, weather and site conditions permitting.

Working hours are **8pm to 5am**, **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

We will not work Friday nights, Saturdays or the Monday 9 June public holiday.

What will this mean for you?

Our work needs to be carried out at night to minimise disruption to traffic and reduce safety risks to our workers, pedestrians, and motorists.

It may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise our impacts by:

- reducing noise and vibration
- turning off equipment when not in use
- positioning equipment away from homes and businesses
- targeted lighting to minimise light spill
- stopping work where possible for respite
- completing noisier tasks by midnight.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. This will include lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h.

At times during work hours, there may be impacts or slight delays when accessing local roads adjacent to James Ruse Drive.

Access for residents will be maintained as much as possible.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
